List of column headings: **Site_ID; Reference_ID; Reference_type; Reference.**

Explanation:

Site_ID: FORMAT: GENERAL. NUMBER. A unique number between 0 and 1309 (generated in the access database from which these spreadsheets are derived). This identifies the site for cross-reference in all tables and can be used to link the tables in a relational database.

Reference_ID: FORMAT GENERAL. NUMBER. A unique number between 0 and 1614 (generated in the MS Access database from which these spreadsheets are derived). This identifies the specific reference for that specific site. NB. The same references occur on more than one occasion where they refer to different sites but each time they will be repeated with a new number in order to maintain the relational database structure.

Reference_type: FORMAT GENERAL. SHORT TEXT. Type of reference source: Book [published book]; Book section; Grey literature report [unpublished site report]; Journal article; other [including web resources].

Reference: FORMAT GENERAL. LONG TEXT. Full details of reference, author first.
