Summary Note on Building Material

A small fragment of unidentified ceramic building material was recovered from context [36]. The red coloured tile is made from London area clay. It is probably the base of a Roman roofing tile or brick dated to AD50-160 (fabric 2452). It was found associated with a sherd of Roman pottery of AD 60–150 date.
