Archaeological Watching Briefs on Utilities Works at London Wall and Blomfield Street (XSZ 11)

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1 Summary for London Archaeologist

City of London

Crossrail utilities works, Blomfield Street and London Wall, EC2 TQ 3273 8154/3293 8150 MOLA (Sam Pfizenmaier) watching brief Jun–Sep 2013 Crossrail XSZ11

A trench 15m east of the junction between Moorgate and London Wall exposed only modern utilities. A trench running between Blomfield Street and London Wall exposed a small, previously unrecorded, section of the City Wall (a Scheduled monument), as well as a section previously exposed and recorded in 2009 (LA13 supp. 1 (2010) 7 (XRF09)). The heavily truncated, isolated fragment of mortared ragstone is consistent in composition with the Roman City Wall. These were sealed by modern utilities, make up and tarmac.
