The medieval and later pottery from this targeted intervention yielded seven sherds of pottery from up to four vessels in contexts [10], [30] and [60], with the large joining fragments in [10] representing the better preserved material. Both [10] and [60] yielded Cheam redware pottery dated 1480–1550 with [30] containing Saxo-Norman material which therefore provides the earliest dated recorded landuse.
