

**A note on two registered finds from Crossrail Central – Farringdon Station,  
Eastern Ticket Hall evaluation (XSF10)**

There are two (non-leather) registered finds from XSF10. A strip of lead <7> from a context dated c 1200–1800 ([54]) is approximately 8x3mm and 2mm thick, has no decoration or rivet holes on its surfaces and is of unknown function. A short length of dark brown wool yarn, doubled back on itself (two strands, twisted) is approximately 62mm long (<15>, [32]). Context [32] is dated by ceramics to the late 16th- or early 17th-century.
