

Note on an accessioned find from C257 Crossrail Central - Blomfield Street Evaluation XSL10

1.1 Introduction and discussion

This note covers the single accessioned find from an archaeological evaluation at Blomfield Street by Museum of London Archaeology. A sherd of Roman natural blue-green glass <1>, [8] was recovered. This could date to any point within the Roman period (AD 43–410) and its original form cannot be identified. It may have come from the shoulder of a necked vessel such as a flask, jug or jar but the surface is not convincing and it could be a chip of a more robust object.
