A Neighbourhood has been defined as a minimum of three structures in a group with a gap at either end separating the unit from adjacent neighbourhoods (Chapman & Gaydarska, 2016). Application of this definition has led to the identification of 153 Neighbourhoods at Nebelivka. The number of structures in a Neighbourhood ranges from three to twenty-seven, with a strong trend towards fewer instances of the larger Neighbourhoods: over half of all Neighbourhoods comprise only three to seven structures (ADS LINK TO
