## **Great Bowden Heritage & Archaeology**

Field Walking at Stan's Field, Leicester Lane, Market Harborough, Leicestershire Grid Reference: SP 72500 89500 Date: 25th October 2009-31st October 2010 Site Code: GBHSF Area walked: 7.44 hectares





**Location:** this large arable field lies to the north of Leicester Lane and east of the A6 between Market Harborough and Kibworth. *(see Fig.1 left)* 

**History:** It was part of Great Bowden parish in the past and was within the North or Galou Field of the medieval open fields system. No visible ridge and furrow earthworks remain today. Pottery finds show that it had been ploughed from medieval times onwards.

The Great Turnpike Road from London to Manchester once passed the eastern boundary of the field. 730 metres north of the field is a rare section of road dating from 1726 and unaltered since the newer elevated section of road was built alongside.

The turnpike was rebuilt after the construction of the Grand Union Canal and raised to bridge the canal and then follow its present route towards Leicester.



The original route was to the east of the present A6 and may be seen on old maps. It would appear to re join the A6 just north of Stan's field but older OS maps show that Stan's field was once in three parishes, Market Harborough (most of the field), Foxton (a strip alongside the present A6) and Lubenham (a small triangular section near the crossroads) and if this was the case the parish boundaries may have followed the route of the old road which could have crossed the field. Nothing of this is visible on the surface and no Lidar tile is available. *(see Fig. 2 left from OS map dated 1885)*

Now the whole field is in Market Harborough. The present farmers named it Stan's Field after Stan Burdett, a previous owner and this is the name we have adopted. We do not know of any historic names. 1950s concrete has been added to aid drainage and we know there was a building, probably near the present barn, connected with the World War II airfield on the far side of Leicester Road. A field pond shown on old maps has been filled in.

**Method:** Fieldwalking in this large field was carried out on two occasions using the traverse and stint method. A total of 48 north-south traverses were walked moving westwards from the north-east corner of the field at 10 metre intervals. Stints were at 30 metre intervals.

This large field created a challenge for us to keep the traverses on their straight line and we incorporated a new system of marking the traverses which proved successful

and was used in all subsequent field walking by the group. Traverse points along each side of the field were marked by a bamboo cane with an old and disused plastic carrier bag firmly attached to the top. This was clearly visible from the far side of the field. Later, we

further refined this method by marking the even numbers with orange bags (Sainsburys) of which we had collected a good number. This made it even clearer to which point the field walker was aiming.

Finds bags for the return journey could be easily left at the relevant cane and full bags left by the cane for collection at the end of the session. The short while it took to set this up was worth it and ensured we covered the whole field accurately. (*see Fig 3 left -Stan's Field, Field walking in 2010*))
