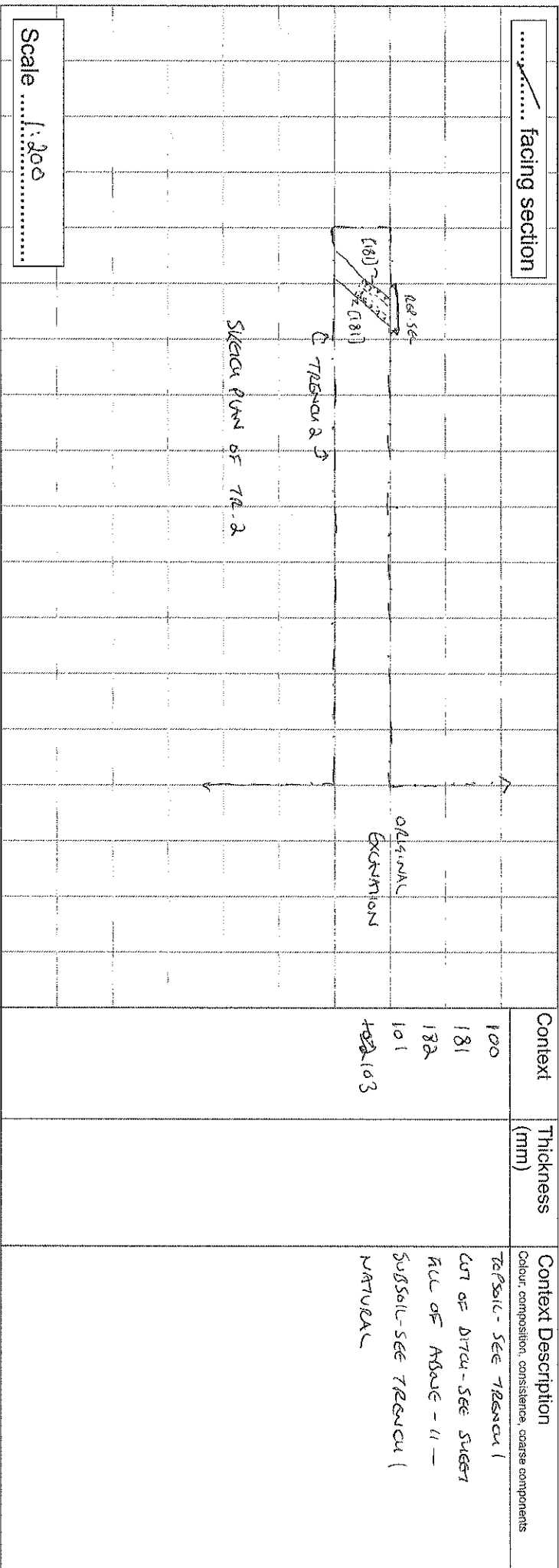
Site Conditions and Topography Site dug to the point of being baked solid (even the turf!) Trench runs S. of original excavation area. Field is standing E-W, with West downhill. At N end of trench there is a deep, un-fenced depression, drawn in representative section.

Remarks. ASIDE FROM PALE PIECES OF STONE, TRENCH AND SITE COMPLETELY DEVOID OF FINDS. NOT EVEN A SINGLE CERAMIC. MATERIAL WAS PROBABLY MOUND DOWNSTAGE. COLOURS DEPOSIT SITS IN N. END OF TRENCH, FROM c.1m TO 8m AWAY FROM SITE EXCAVATION 4 METERS IS A MIX OF SILTY SANDS, SANDY SILTS
