The [] context numbers appended to the original accession numbers in the entries above give an approximate idea of where the objects were found in the chamber grave and highlight any possible associations – their attribution is not strictly stratigraphic in nature and is intended for general information only. The cited contexts are:

[168] primary burial deposit within coffin area

[169] area of organic artefact in south-west of chamber;

[170] area of wooden box in south-west of chamber;

[225] Fe fittings for wood coffin (group number);

[235] wood from foot end of coffin, preserved against large cauldron

[246] decayed organic residue on base of chamber (floor/flooring?);

[248] decayed remains of chamber walls (vertical boards/staves);

[250] sand- and gravel-based fill in tub (excavated in conservation laboratory).
