The Library is open to members every week day (except New Year's Day, Good Friday and Christinas Day) from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. from April 1st to September 30th, and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. from October 1st to March 31st. It is also open every Wednesday until 9 p.m.

Each member is entitled to borrow from the Library such books as he may require, but so that there are not more than three volumes issued to him and unreturned at any one time.

No volume may be kept by a member for more than four weeks without the previous consent of the Council.

Members keeping books longer than the time allowed shall pay a fine of one shilling per week for each volume so kept.


All books must, for the purpose of examination, be returned to the Library on or before the Wednesday preceding the Annual Meeting, under a fine of two shillings and sixpence per volume, payable to the Society by the member in default. All books shall remain in the Library from the Wednesday preceding the Annual Meeting until after that meeting.


Manuscripts and books of special value are not allowed to circulate without the previous permission of the Council, to obtain which, application should be made, in writing, to the Librarian.

A volume lost or injured must be replaced or restored or its value paid to the Society by the member so losing or damaging it.

CENTENARY VOLUME, 1813-1913.



At the Annual Meeting of the Newcastle Society of Antiquaries, held at the Castle of Newcastle on Wednesday, the 29th January, 1913, His Grace the Duke of Northumberland, President of the Society, in the Chair.

It was resolved, on the motion of Mr. J. C. Hodgson, seconded by Mr. R. O. Heslop: That a small committee of three be appointed to consider a suggestion of the noble chairman as to the publication of a history of the Society to commemorate the centenary, and report thereon to the next meeting of the council, and that such committee consist of Messrs. Welford, Dendy, and Hodgson.

At the ordinary Monthly Meeting of the Council of the Society held in the old library at the Castle, Newcastle, on Wednesday, the 26th of February, 1913, Mr. F. W. Dendy, D.C.L., a vice-president, in the chair.

The chairman announced that the council had received the report of its Committee appointed to consider the best means to carry out the suggestion of the President at the January meeting for the publication of a centenary volume, which they had confirmed and recommended to the Society for adoption. The suggestions of the committee were:—

- (1) That the current volume of Archaeologia Aeliana should be kept small, and that another volume, containing historical and biographical articles commemorating the centenary should be issued about the end of the year.
- (2) That the volume should contain chapters on (a) the foundation and history of the Society; (b) the library, collections, etc.; (c) chronological lists of patrons, presidents, secretaries, and treasurers; (d and e) chronological and alphabetical lists of members from its foundation; and (f) short biographies, with bibliographies, of all deceased members who have contributed to the transactions.
- (3) That the same committee be re-appointed, with the addition of the secretaries, to whom further details be left.
