175. ROBERT BERTRAM, round, 22 mm., brown wax, armorial, shield couched, bearing an orle (*gold an orle azure*). Above the shield is a visored and mantled helm, with eye-slit and crest of a faun's head.

S' ROBERTI BERTRAM.

149. ROGER MAUDUIT, round, 22 mm., brown wax, armorial, shield couched, bearing ermine two bars (*gules*). Above the shield is a lattice-visored helm with mantling and fan crest.

S' ROGERI MAVDVYT · TC'II.

149. ALIENORE, COUNTESS OF ANGUS, round, 26 mm., brown wax, four shields of arms in cross, the points to the centre.
 1. Crusilly a cinquefoil (*gules crusilly a cinquefoil gold*)—Umfraville. 2. A fess between three popinjays (*silver a fess gules between three popinjays vert*)—Lumley. 3. Three chevrons and a label of three points (*gold three chevrons gules and a label azure*)—Clare. 4. Ermine three bars (*gules*)—Mauduit.

S' ALIENORE · COMITISSE.

33. WALRAN OF HORTON, shield shaped, 30×27 mm., green wax, armorial barry of six a bend ermine(?) (blazon unknown).

† S' GVALERANNI VICCOMITIS.

239. WILLIAM OF WESSINGTON, round, 23 mm., red wax, armorial, the shield, which hangs from a tree's branches, bears two bars and in chief three molets (*gules two bars and in chief three molets silver*).

283. JOHN OF LUMLEY, round, imperfect, 40 mm., red wax, armorial, a couched shield bearing a fess between three popinjays (*silver a fess gules between three popinjays vert*)—Lumley. The shield is surmounted by a visored and mantled helm with the crest of a popinjay standing upon the points of two horns.

24. MARMADUKE OF TWENGE, round, 45 mm., green wax, armorial, a fess between three popinjays (*gules a fess between three popinjays silver*).

120. WILLIAM BASSET, round, 21 mm., red wax, armorial, within an ornamental border a shield of arms bearing two bars and in chief three chaplets (*silver two bars azure in chief three chaplets gules*).
255. JOHN NEVILLE, round, 33 mm., red wax, armorial, a couched shield charged with a saltire (*gules a saltire silver*), surmounted by a mantled helm with crest of a bull's head, on each side of it is a large black letter **b**.

KEY TO SEALS—PLATE IV

207 (2). WILLIAM OF MENVILLE, round, 23 mm., brown wax, armorial, the shield placed within a panel of tracery bears a cross engrailed (blazon unknown).

381. THOMAS TEMPEST, oval signet, 20×17 mm., red wax, armorial, quarterly I and IV (*silver*) a bend engrailed between six martlets (*sable*): Tempest; II and III (*gules*) a cinquefoil in an orle of crosses crosslet (*gold*): Umfraville on an escutcheon of pretence. . . . (?) Crest, on a mantled helm a dragon's head rased.

207 (1). ROGER OF WIDDRINGTON, round, 24 mm., red wax, armorial, the shield, hanging from a tree's branches, bears quarterly a baston (*quarterly silver and gules a baston sable*).

* SIGILL · ROGERI · DE · WIDDRINGTONE.

239. ROGER OF BLAKISTON, round, 24 mm., red wax, armorial, the shield placed within tracery bears two bars and in chief three cocks (*silver two bars in chief three cocks gules*).

S' ROGERI DE: BLAKESTON.

322. . . . KILLINGWORTH, round, imperfect, 24 mm., red wax, armorial, the shield, hanging from the branches of a tree, bears two bars and in chief three voided cinquefoils.

166. WILLIAM OF ACTON, round, 24 mm., brown wax, device within a circle, a cross between four lions rampant.

* S' WILLELMI DE ACTVN.

8. ROBERT OF AMUNDEVILLE, round, 35 mm., brown wax, device a lion passant to the sinister.

231. ROGER OF WESSINGTON, round, 21 mm., red wax, armorial, on a bend between eight billets three swans (blazon unknown).

S' ROGERI DE WESINGTONNE.

288. RALPH OF EVER, round, 31 mm., red wax, armorial, the shield, placed within tracery and hanging from the branches of a tree, bears quarterly on a bend three escallops (*quarterly gold and gules on a bend sable three escallops silver*).
