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4. Authors receive twenty-five free copies of their papers. More copies can be had at cost price if ordered at proof stage.
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6. Owing to the process now adopted for printing *A.A.* the lines of illustrations should be drawn more firmly than formerly and stipples should be relatively coarse.
7. Authors are reminded that alterations at proof stage are prohibitively expensive, so the text as submitted should be final.
