- 1: Prehistoric (Preh)
- 2: Roman period (Rm)
- 3: Anglo-Saxon period (AS) (c. 1500–1100)
- 4: Medieval (Med) (c. 1100–1500)
- 5: PM (PM) (c. 1500 onwards)
