Annual Report, March, 2013

The highlight for the Ife Branch in 2012 was the successful hosting of the ABM and 40th Anniversary celebration of the Ife Branch held at the Staff Club of the University. This included lectures, quiz competition and an exhibition.

The quiz competition organized for High Schools around Ile-Ife took place on Thursday April 26, 2012. The questions bothered on issues about the

Representatives of the branch also attended parts of the ceremony for Prof. Obot in Lagos.

On October 31st 2012 the branch in conjunction with IFRA Ibadan hosted a lecture titled **Archeology of Ritual Context in Northern Ghana** by Timothy Insoll, a Professor from the School of Arts, Languages and Culture of the University of Manchester, U.K. The event which took place at the New Natural History Museum, Obafemi Awolowo University was well attended and generated a lot of interests from scholars on the university campus.

A series of programmes, lecture and events have already been slated for 2013, the branch is putting the negative events of 2012 behind and forging ahead for a
