REPORT ON THE INCINERATED BONES.

The larger pieces of cremated bone can be identified as belonging to an adult human skeleton.

There are pieces of bones of cranium—parietal, occipital, and also one piece of right temporal and one piece of left temporal, each showing the articular surface for condyle of lower jaw; eight pieces of vertebræ and three fragmentary ribs; fragment of upper articular end of a humerus and two pieces of lower articular ends of humeri—one right and other left; two fragments of forearm bones and proximal phalanx of right thumb; several pieces of shafts of femora and tibiæ and upper articular surface of a tibia.

The weight of the cremated bone is one pound seven ounces.
