

Appendix C. Units Log

Appendix C was compiled with the aim of providing a summary description of stratigraphic relations between the 1487 Units excavated at the Souskiou *Laona* settlement and cemetery complex in 1992 and between 2001 and 2011. The relations established are based principally on the written account and notes of Edgar Peltenburg, which has been further augmented, amended, clarified, and complemented on the basis of site sections and plans, trenches Harris matrixes and archival unit sheets in Cyprus and Edinburgh. As expected, during this process, certain errors, omissions and incompatibilities were noticed, and where possible corrected. The following table functions as a guide to the content and abbreviations used in Appendix C.

Column	Explanation
Unit	Unit number in sequential order. Duplicate units are indicated in notes in the Description column. The following units were not used during excavation: 59, 100, 238-300, 334, 340, 382, 476-477, 530, 825-826, 881-889, 958, 970, 1190-1192. The following units did not have a record sheet and were not located on site plans/sections or Harris matrixes, hence have been removed: 99, 799, 817.
PUG	Part of Unit Group, as designated by Charalambos Paraskeva (see Chap. 2).
PB/F	Part of Building or Feature, as designated by Edgar Peltenburg (see Chap. 6). It is noted that not all units grouped under feature or building numbers are labelled as such in Chap. 6, nor do the chapter descriptions of buildings/features include all numbers designated as belonging to them here.
PT	Part of Tomb, as designated by Lindy Crewe (see Chap. 8).
PO	Part of Other, namely a specific feature (e.g. pit, posthole, cut, etc.), but not of a building or tomb; used mostly for fills.

Class	Class code assigned to unit during excavation (see below).

Operation	<p>Operation where the unit is located, as follows:</p> <p>A About 250m² excavation on flat shoulder between the East Ridge crest and the Vathykakas stream at the 140m contour, max 90x35m.</p> <p>B About 100m² excavation at the 160m contour on crest of East Ridge and on North face.</p> <p>A/B Trial trenches on the slopes between A and B.</p> <p>C About 600 m² cemetery area and Period V occupation at the N end of East Ridge.</p> <p>D Trial trenches on the West Ridge (including the N face, W spur and S slope).</p> <p>E Trial trenches on saddle between East and West Ridges and slopes below to Vathykakas River</p>
Trench	Trench within which the unit is located. For trench locations see Pl. 4.2 (settlement), and Pl. 32 (cemetery); OG = Off Grid, units that do not fall in the trench grid used at the cemetery.
Status	Relative metric for unit integrity based on its content in respect to the anticipated dating. For the abbreviations used see Table 2.6.
Description	Brief description of the units, focusing mostly on stratigraphic relations between units and/or their overarching unit groups. No abbreviations are used, save for the ones regarding chronological analysis and cardinal points, for which see page xvii.
Ordering	The Unit column holds both numerical and textual characters, hence sorting sequentially fails. This column can be used instead to sequentially sort the units, as it holds only numbers.
LATE	An indicator whether the unit contain post-Chalcolithic material.
Year Excavated	Designation of the year the unit was excavated.
