| ORDER | LAYER | DESCRIPTION |

| 10 | H60 ④ 1 | Topsoil |
| 7 | H60 ④ 2 | Top filling of later version of kiln 4. |
| 4 | H60 ④ 3 | Lower filling of later version of kiln 4. |
| 8 | H60 ④ 4 | Upper filling of stokehole; black, not differing visibly from lower filling (6), in colour. Later version of kiln 4. |
| 2 | H60 ④ 5 | In sand, which just covers the pedestal stump of the EARLIER version of kiln 4; slopes to grid-west. Equals 9. |
| 6 | H60 ④ 6 | Lower filling of stokehole of later version of kiln 4. |
| 9 | H60 ④ 7 | Filling above flue arch of later version of kiln 4. Later than kiln 4. |
| 3 | H60 ④ 8 | Black ash filling in flue of later version of kiln 4. |
| 1 | H60 ④ 9 | In sand layer in very bottom of kiln; associated with the sand covering the stump of the pedestal belonging to the earlier kiln. This = layer 5 and pre-dates the building of the later version of kiln 4, though the time-lapse between period 1 & period 2 may have been nil. |
| 5 | H60 ④ 10 | Whole mortarium standing at end of flue, facing out into stokehole. ? part of a sealing of flue for last firing. |

Natural = Sand with Stone over rock
