GLASS FURNACE = Furnace or 'kiln' 7A.

- M87 GLASS FURNACE. 1964. From beyond the stoke area; furnace cleaned; half-section of stoke area showing small stone and shale platform adjoining furnace. 2 negs. (Enlarged) VERSION A
- M88 GLASS FURNACE. 1964 looking across the glass furnace towards the stone and shale platform; showing the trickle of solidified glass on the furnace lining near the scale. 2 negs. VERSION A
- M89 GLASS FURNACE. 1964 Closer than M87; shows more platform. (Enlarged)
- M90 GLASS FURNACE. 1964 As M87 but closer. (Enlarged) VERSION A

ALL 1964 PHOTOS ARE VERSION A (i.e. latest version).

- M91 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 Looking towards the stoke area. A little patching removed before rest of tiny stoking area taken out. 2 negs. VERSION A/B
- M92 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 Version before the broken tiles were used as a floor. VERSION D
- M93 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 VERSION D, before the broken tiles were used as a floor; one of the earlier linings. Platform adjoining furnace removed. Uppermost filling of post-pit pre-dating glass furnace visible behind glass furnace.
- M94 GLASS FURNACE. 1964 Looking toward the little stone and shale platform adjoining the furnace. Stoke area still partially filled. Trickle of solidified glass near scale. 3 negs. VERSION A This is the latest version and is basically Version B with massive patching, especially on the west side.
- M95 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 Version with floor made of broken tiles but with all the later patching removed. 3 negs. (Enlarged) VERSION B
- M96 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 An early version. 2 negs. (Enlarged) VERSION E This is substantially version F with patching, some of which is clearly visible on west side.
- M97 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 VERSION E. See M96.
- M98 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 VERSION C, probably the version the tiles initially go with.
- M99 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 (Enlarged) VERSION E. See M96.
- M100 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 Detail to show the hole near the scale, thought at the time perhaps to be for bellows. VERSION C 2 negs.
- M103 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 As M98 but slightly closer. VERSION C. No print.
- M104 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 Earliest version. VERSION F.
- M105 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 As M95 but not as close. VERSION B. No print.

- M106 Pit pre-dating and next to glass furnace; see M07. 2 negs.
- M107 GLASS FURNACE. 1969 VERSION F, earliest version. The little 'platform' of shale and stone adjoining the furnace has been removed, also the contents of an earlier pit underneath. Shows also the post-pit behind and pre-dating the glass furnace.
- M108 1969 Small kiln (7C) slightly north-west of the glass furnace with tiny cylindrical 'furnace' (7E), opening off the stokehole. 2 negs.
- M109 1969 Kiln 7C & 'furnace' 7E taken from the post-pit behind the glass furnace.
- M110 1969 Kiln 7C & 'furnace' 7E and part of post-pit behind and pre-dating glass furnace.
- M111 1969 Kiln 7C & 'furnace' 7E, the post-pit behind & pre-dating the glass furnace. Looking towards the back of the glass furnace + stone & shale platform and a post-hole.
- M112 1969 Kiln 7B. Looking towards the Glass furnace.
- M113 1969 Kiln 7B. From stokehole end. 2 negs.
- M114 1969 Kiln 7B. From end of kiln. 3 negs.
- M115 1969 Kiln 7B. Inside of kiln, looking to flue. 2 negs.
- M116 1969 Kiln 7D. Looking south across the kiln.
- M117 1969 Kiln 7D. Looking east into kiln 7D. 2 negs.
- M118 1969 Kiln 7D. Looking south across Kiln 7F in foreground & Kiln 7D.
- M119 1969 Kiln 7D. Looking south across kiln 7D.
- M120 1969 Kiln 7D. Looking north across kiln 7D. 2 negs.
- M121 1970 Kiln 7G. Looking north-west into kiln.
- M122 1970 Kiln 7G. View as M121.
- M123 1970 Kiln 7G. Looking into kiln from stokehole area.
- M124 1970 Kiln 7G beyond ranging rod; Pit VIII in foreground.
- M125 1970 Looking north-west, into Kiln 7G on right; pit VIII on left; post-hole 3 (1970) beyond.
- M126 1970 Similar view to M125.
- M127 1970 Pit VIII. Sinkage removed; clay & stone sealing visible. 2 negs
- M128 1970 Pit VIII - half section.
- M129 1970 Pit VIII - half section.
- M130 1970 Pit VIII - half section. Colour photo.

- M131 1969 Three post-holes together positioned centrally between glass furnace etc and working floor. 2 negs.
- M132 1969 Post-hole. Isolated posthole, north of Kiln 7C.
- M133 1969 Area view. Looking from south-west towards the glass furnace and the adjoining tiny stone and shale area. The plough furrow is that which passes above Kiln 7C.
- M134 1969 Area view. Looking south-west across the glass furnace. 2 negs.
- M135 1969 Area view. Glass furnace with latest patching removed; unexcavated Kiln 7B clear in foreground. plough furrow under ranging rod. Three negs.
- M136 1969 Area view. Glass furnace with latest patching removed; other features as above.
- M137 1969 Area view. In the foreground left to right, Kiln 7C and furnace 7E, glass furnace and Kiln 7B. Working area in background.
- M138 1969 Area view. Kiln 7B and glass furnace with Kiln 7C and furnace 7E in background. Latest patching in Glass furnace removed. 4 negs.
- M139 1969 Area view. Ditto. 2 negs*.
- M140 1969 Area view. Ditto.
- M141 1969 Area view. Links with M142 over posthole (layer 69) and very edge of the 3 postholes together near to the working floor. Latest complete lining of glass furnace with tile floor. 2 negs.
- M142 1969 Area view. 2 negs. Links with M141. Working floor and Kilns 7D and 7F. Kiln 7G and Pit VIII are just beyond the upper lefthand quarter.
- M143 1969 Post-hole. Not identified.
- M144 1969 Post-hole. Same posthole as M143.*
