

MANCETTER COINS (K.F.HARTLEY EXCAVATION)

1. Claudius (41-54). Dupondius. Rev. Ceres seated l., S-C, (probably a copy). As R.I.C. I, p.129/67. Poor. Mancetter Kilns W (1) 2.
2. Nero (54-68). As. Rev. Victory left with backless insc. SPQR; S-C. R.I.C. I pp.166-7/318-331. Poor. W71 (20) 45 [19].
3. Nero. Semis (or Quadsans). Rev. Roma seated l. etc.; S-C. R.I.C. I pp.161-3/239-272. Poor. W71 (20) 8 [8].
4. Vespasian (69-79). As, 71. Rev. [IVDAEA CAPTA]. Jewess seated under palm tree, etc.; S-C. R.I.C. II pp.73-4/489-91. Very poor. W71 (22) 117 [31].
5. Vespasian or Titus As. Rev. Eagle on globe, head right; S-C. R.I.C. II ? Poor, corroded at edge. W70 (17) 18 [14].
6. ? early 1st century. As. obv. Head left (?). Rev. Figure standing. Very poor. W71 (20) 9 [11].
7. Trajan (98-117). As, c.114-7. Rev. SENATVS POPVLVSQVE ROMANVS Felicitas l.; S-C. Fine but for corrosion. R.I.C. II, p.292/673 (given only as Sestertius). W71 (22) 102 [32].
8. Antoninus Pius (?) (138-161). Sestertius. Rev. Forturia (?) standing left; S-C. About fair. W71 (22) 113 [28].
9. Septimius Severus (?) (193-211). As. Rev. seated figure. Poor. W70 (25) 11 [19].
10. Julia Donna, under Caracalla (211-217). Sestertius. Rev. IVNONEM. Juno l. with peacock; S-C. Fair, some wear. R.I.C. IV pt I, p.310/585. W70 (23) 14 [20].
11. Official Antoninianus of mid to late 3rd century or semis of 1st century (no design visible). Very poor. M65 III + (2).
12. Either an Antoninianus of mid 3rd century or worn down 2nd or 3rd brass of earlier period. Very poor. M65 T 10 (1).
13. Radiate imitation of Claudius II? Rev. Providentia type. All in fragments. W70 (17) 15 [13].
14. Radiate imitation of Tetricus II. Rev. Sacred implements type. Fair. W70 (8) 5 [11].
15. Radiate imitation of later 3rd century. Rev. Mars standing left. Poor. W71 (20) 38 [17].
16. Radiate imitation of later 3rd century. Rev. type unidentified. Poor and broken. W70 (17) 15 [12].
17. Radiate imitation of later 3rd century. Rev. type unidentified. Fair to poor. W71 (20) 67 [25].
18. Constantine II Caesar. AS, c.320. Trier mint. Rev. VIRTVS EXERCIT. Standard insc. VOT/XX with captive seated on ground either side.

R.I.C. VII, p.188/273-8. Fragmentary. W70 (22) 35 [24].

19. Magnentius. AE 1 cut down to AE 3, c.353. Amiens mint (?) Rev.
SALVS DD NN AVG ET CAES. Large * As. R.I.C. VIII p.123/34 ff.
Extremely fine. W71 (22) 102 [27].

1. Antoninianns or Radiate imitation, possibly based on Claudius II (?)
Very poor. Hartshill '61.
2. AE 2 but fairly large raised head and could be an As. worn right down.
