WOODTON.—The "Robert Suckling" who died in 1689 was perhaps the donor of the "secular dish" or "saucer." His son Robert died in 1707, and his grandson Robert in 1735. This last was brother to Maurice Suckling, Rector of Woodton and Barsham, whose daughter Catherine was mother of Horatio Nelson. *Ex Inform.* Rev. F. Lee, Rector of Woodton.

Another such "saucer" is at Rackheath, Norfolk.
