

FULL ANALYSIS OF HUMAN REMAINS FROM FIELD 133 OF THE A1 WIDENING SCHEME

Summary

During excavations by Northern Archaeological Associates, twocontexts of burnt bone were recovered from Field 133 of the A1 Leeming to Barton Joint Venture for widening of the A1. Upon analysis it was determined that the quantity of bone recovered was too small, and the bone too fragmentary, to determine if they were human or animal in origin (Table 1). Therefore, no further analysis was undertaken.
