

REPORT OF THE COUNCIL

FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 1951

The Council of the SURREY ARCHÆOLOGICAL SOCIETY has much pleasure in presenting its 97th ANNUAL REPORT, with the ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR 1951

EDITORIAL.—It is with regret that the resignation of Mr. W. F. Rankine, F.S.A.Scot., as Hon. Editor was received by the Council last May. He had been a very valued Hon. Editor since 1950 and had produced Volumes L and LI of the *Collections*.

The Council are pleased to record the election of Dr. R. Offor, B.A., as Hon. Editor in his place. Dr. Offor is a Fellow of University College, London, and was for some years Librarian to the University of Leeds, of which he is now Librarian Emeritus. He was President of the Thoresby Society. His present official position is that of Library Adviser to the Inter University Council for Higher Education in the Colonies, which is necessitating journeys overseas.

No new publication was issued to Members during 1951.

Dr. Offor hopes to publish Volume LII of the Society's *Collections* this year.

LOCAL HISTORY.—Further Corresponding Members have been appointed to the Local History Committee, which is now linked in this way with the newly formed Surrey Council of Social Service and with twelve other county bodies. Informal contacts have also been maintained, especially with Surrey delegates to the Third Annual Meeting of the Standing Conference for Local History held on December 3, at which the Committee was represented by Messrs. T. E. C. Walker and J. H. Harvey.

The compilation of records for the Surrey branch of the Local History Recording Scheme has been undertaken by members of the Committee, but it has not yet been possible to launch the scheme generally owing to delays in publication of the explanatory Notes.

The Surrey County Council has now published the greatly enlarged Fourth Edition of its *List of Antiquities* in the Administrative County; proofs were read by the Committee on behalf of the Society, and various suggestions made. Another publication of the year is the outstanding parish history: *The Free Men of Charwood*, by our members Mrs. Lane and Mrs. Sewill; promotion of the research for and compilation of this book was among the first works of the Committee after its inception.

The Committee assisted in connection with the Festival of Britain Exhibition held by the Royal Borough of Kingston from July 18 to 25, and has also given assistance or advice in connection with research in the parishes of Ashted, Chelsham, Chessington, Chiddingfold, Fetcham, Merton, Morden, Newington, Reigate, Sanderstead and Walton-on-Thames.

EXCAVATIONS.—*Little Bookham Church.* Under Mr. Ruby's supervision, and at the request of the Rector, the Rev. A. L. Drinkwater, some trenches were dug on the southern side of the Church in order, if possible, to find some trace of the original Norman South Aisle. Some trace of the foundation of this wall, and much material belonging to the original South Aisle, was discovered, but the digging of graves in this area had displaced most of the foundation of the South wall. Some 13th- and 14th-century pottery was found during the work.

Final Work at "The Mounts," Leatherhead. Again with assistance from members both of this Society and of the Leatherhead and District Local History Society, a final week's excavations were carried out at this site, under the direction of Mr. A. T. Ruby, M.B.E. The object of this work was to explore the old highway which once gave access to the site and to learn something about its eastward extension, beyond the point at which it was examined in the previous year. The work, in spite of its limited extent and short duration, was entirely successful and much was learnt as regards the road's construction from the two sections which were dug. Finds, small in number and importance, include part of the upper fastening or attachment of an early medieval purse probably of 14th century date. (It is of bronze with traces of original gilding.)

Medieval Kiln, Vicar's Haw, Limpsfield. The excavation of this site was resumed in the spring of 1951, under the direction of Mr. Hope Taylor. The main object of the work, namely the location and thorough investigation of the kiln itself, was achieved. The kiln was broadly elliptical in plan, one side bounded by a large stone-faced buttress of uncertain function. This had a core of rubble, containing fragments of the earliest pottery found on the site, the great mass of the material being dated to the mid-13th century. A splendid pottery series, comprising jugs, cooking-pots, pie-dishes, skillets, pipkins and large bowls, brings the enormous bulk of material from the medieval kiln-sites from the Limpsfield district to the point at which it can be, and should be, published. These sites are of more than merely local significance. A novel, and important, feature of the Vicar's Haw site was the potter's workshop beside the kiln.

Further Celtic Field Areas in Surrey. Celtic fields have been found on Box Hill, White Hill (Caterham), Coulsdon Golf Course and Riddlesdown (Purley), by Mr. Hope Taylor. Air-reconnaissance has been arranged, and, when this and ground surveys have been completed, publication will take the form of a supplement to "*Celtic Agriculture in Surrey*" (Sy.A.C., Vol. 50) in a future volume. The White Hill fields appear to be in association with a contemporaneous farmstead and road.

Abinger Motte Excavations. The full report on this work has now been published in the *Journal of the Royal Archæological Institute* (Vol. CVII).

Abinger Hammer. Major E. Beddington Behrens, M.C., having shown great public spirit in the investigation and preservation of the Mesolithic dwelling-pit and the Norman motte at Abinger, has placed us further in his debt by erecting a small museum over the site of the former monument. This is to house the important series of "finds" from the excavations. Mural panels, designed and executed by Brian Hope Taylor, F.S.A., set the exhibits in an informative context. The date when the Museum will be opened to the public is to be announced shortly.

The Chairman and Members of the Visits Committee would like to record their gratitude to the owners of houses, incumbents of parishes and lecturers for their assistance in making these Visits such a success during 1951.

The Council desires to record its sense of the good services given to the Society by its Honorary Officers, the many excavators, research workers, the leaders and lecturers at visits and, indeed, all who have contributed to its work.

FINANCE.—Our Annual Report for 1949 drew attention to the gap between our expenditure and income, and the Honorary Treasurer at that time was very concerned at the trend of events but had hoped that with a voluntary increase in subscriptions some improvement would result in the following year or so. Unfortunately, the adverse balance continued and the Council having discussed the matter in considerable detail, felt it their duty to call a Special Meeting of the Society to recommend an increase in the annual subscription. The Council regretted the necessity for this move, but drew attention to the fact that this was the first increase in the fixed subscription for a great number of years. It is hoped that for the present at least we shall be able to balance our revenue against our commitments, but in today's uncertain financial con-

ditions this matter is bound to cause the Society some concern for a year or two to come.

As the system of Accounts set out on page 116 has been varied from that adopted by the Society formerly, it is not easy for Members to compare the figures with past years, but it will be noted that the Society's Investments have been reduced by about £550 from £2,772 to £2,215. The sale of these securities became necessary to wipe out the bank overdraft of £778 existing on January 1, 1951.

The 1952 year commences with net liquid assets of £48 16s. and assuming the income from subscriptions, etc., is normal and the cost of publishing Volume LII is approximately the same as the last volume, there will be an estimated deficit of over £200 at the end of the year.

It will thus be seen that if the Society is to pay it way and avoid further depletion of the Investments and publish a volume annually, which the Council is anxious to do, the income must be increased by at least £200 per annum. It is interesting to note that the cost of printing Volume XL in 1940 was £230 and Volume LI in 1950 was £682; this one item explains the need for additional income.

BY-LAWS FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF THE LIBRARY

1. The Library shall be open for the use of Members daily from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m., with the exception of Sundays and the usual general holidays.

2. Members whose annual subscription is not in arrear may borrow for home reading not more than three volumes at a time and may exchange them as often as desired, provided that they do not have in their possession more than three volumes.

3. A Register shall be kept, in which shall be entered the title and author of every book borrowed, the name and address of the borrower, the date of drawing of the book, and the date of its return. No book may be retained for a longer period than *Two months*, unless special permission is given by the Librarian. Books should not be returned to the shelves, but left on the centre table for the Librarian to replace.

4. Members borrowing any book from the Library shall be responsible to the Society for its safe return in good condition. Any loss or damage must be made good by the borrower.

5. Persons who are not members of the Society may be admitted to the Library to consult volumes, on the introduction, personal or in writing, of a Member, who shall be responsible for the care and safety of any books so consulted by the person he introduces.

6. Every book taken from the shelves by Member or student working in the Library must be returned to the shelf from which it was removed.

7. Persons who are not Members may for special reasons be allowed to borrow books at the discretion of the Librarian.

8. Folios, and other such works as the Committee may determine, including Victoria County History of Surrey, Brayley's History of Surrey, Aubrey's History of Surrey, Surrey Place Names, Surrey Archæological Collections and any MSS. whatsoever, shall not be removed from the Library without the special permission of the Committee. Certain copies of Surrey Archæological Collections may be borrowed on application to the Librarian.

9. Members wishing to borrow books by post should apply direct to the Librarian, the Surrey Archæological Society Library, Castle Arch, Guildford, and are required to refund any postage.

AMENDMENTS TO RULES

At the close of the Annual Meeting held on May 19, 1951, a Special General Meeting was held to approve the alteration in the following Rule of the Society, in accordance with Rule XXII.

“Rule VIII. All payments shall be made to the Treasurer, to the account of the Society, at such Banking House as the Society may direct; and every cheque shall be signed by the Treasurer or some other person or persons authorised by the Council.”

At the Annual Meeting held on May 24, 1952, a Special Meeting was held and the alteration in the following Rule of the Society was approved, in accordance to Rule XXII.

Resolved that Rule VI be amended to read:

“Each member elected on or after the 1st day of January, 1952, shall pay an Entrance Fee of 10s. 6d. and an annual subscription of One Guinea (£1 1s. 0d.) or £20 in lieu thereof, as a composition for life. Those persons who were members prior to that date shall pay an annual subscription of One Guinea (£1 1s. 0d.) or £15 in lieu thereof, as a composition for life. Societies and Institutions shall not be entitled to pay a composition. From January, 1953, relatives of a member residing at his or her address may be elected without entrance fee, and will pay an annual subscription of ten shillings and sixpence (10s. 6d.) and be entitled to all privileges of membership, except that they shall not receive the Society’s publications. The Council may remit the entrance fee of any member who is under the age of 21 years at the time of his (or her) nomination and may reduce his (or her) annual subscription to 10s. 6d. while under that age. Any member intending to resign must signify this intention in writing before January 1 of any year, or will be liable to pay the subscription for the ensuing year.”
