

Two Arrowheads from Frensham

The arrowheads were found by the late Mr A Edwards in the 1960s in the general area of Frensham Little Pond (centred SU 860 415). They are presently in the possession of Mr R S Hickling of Kennel Farm, Frensham.

- A A hollow-based arrowhead in dark grey flint of late Neolithic date. Length 27mm. Width 20mm (estimated).
- B A barbed and tanged arrowhead in honey coloured flint of Bronze Age date. Length 32mm (estimated). Width 17mm.

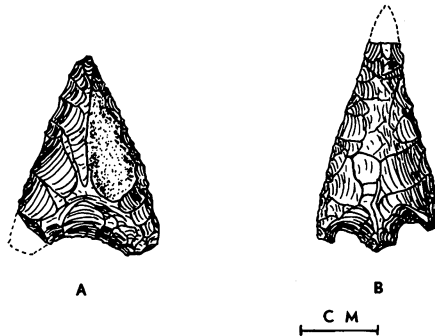


Fig 1. Two arrowheads from Frensham
