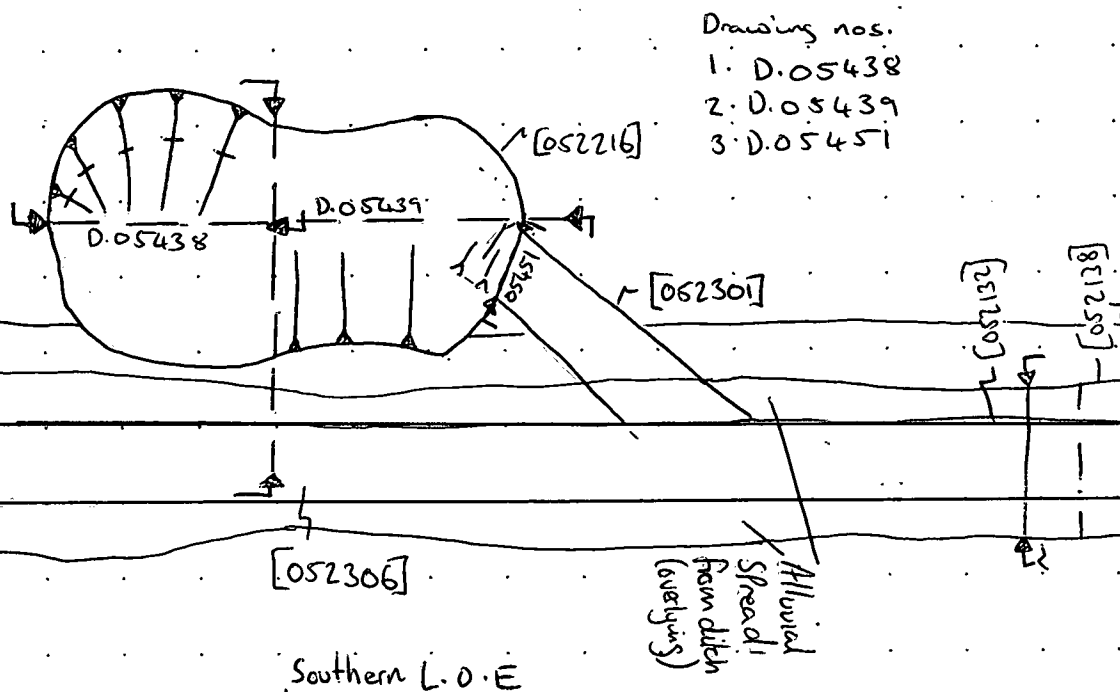

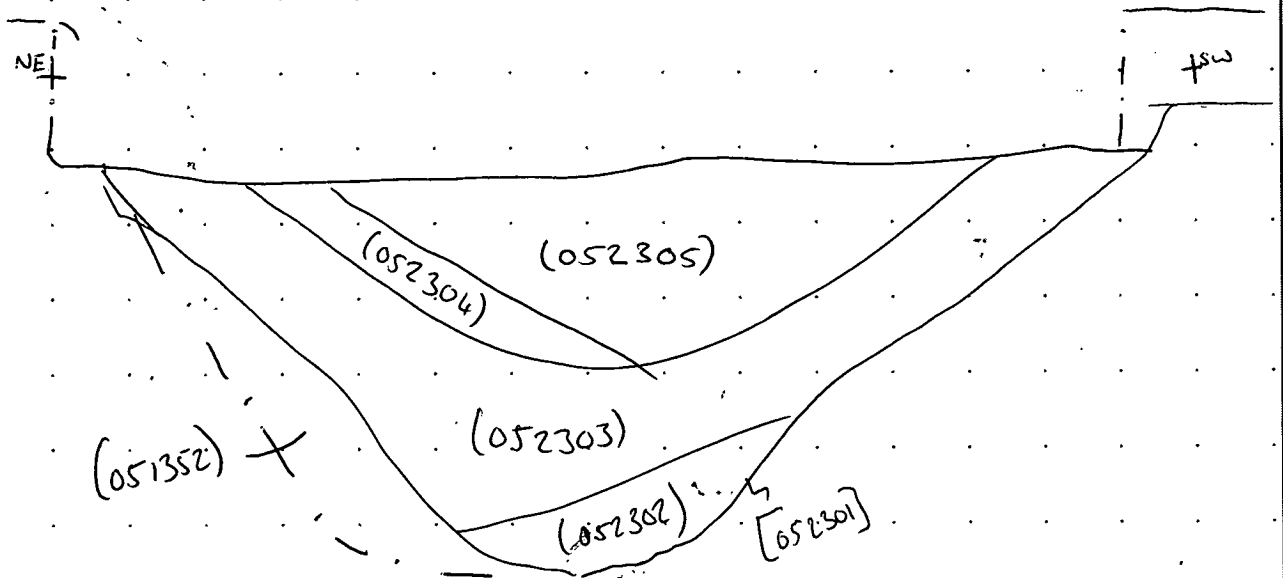

This secondary fill of the NW-SE ditch [052301] is comprised of a mixture of clay and the sandy natural. It appears to be an alluvial deposit and looks to have been deposited whilst wet (note fill deposition pattern in section sketch).

Some pottery shards which seem to be Iron Age were recovered from this fill.

It is unclear whether this fill was deposited during use or disuse, however there are two clear fill above, suggesting the ditch remained in use following this deposit.
