EXTENSIONS: LENGTH = 1.08m, WIDTH = 0.65m, THICKNESS = 0.14m
INCLUSIONS: Moderate medium and small pebbles (0.02 → 0.05m size)
- Bone fragments, probably related to inhumation (380005)
- Metal: nail fragments and nails. The presence of nails in the W side, with an oval ^{regular} shape, impossibly suggests the presence of a wooden coffin not currently preserved. *
INTERPRETATION: the presence of a big quantity pottery in the ground adjacent to and possibly full vases in the burial.
