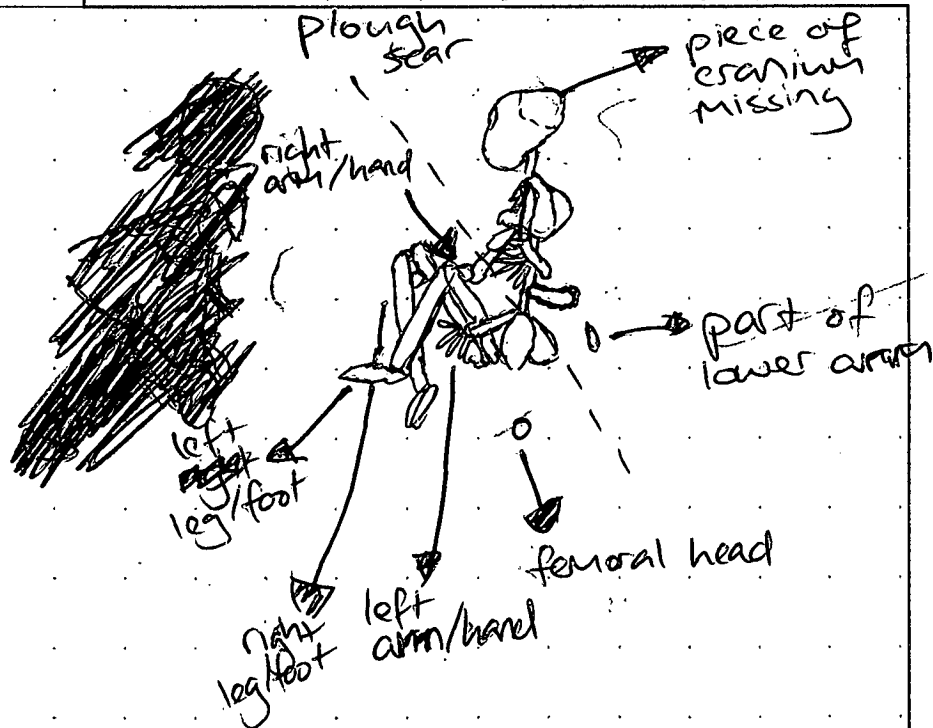

PLOUGH MAY HAVE GONE THROUGH THE LUMBAR REGION, AS THE BONES WERE FRAGMENTED AND SCATTERED THERE. RIBS WERE ALSO VERY FRAGMENTED AND SKULL WAS DAMAGED BY EXCAVATION. SMALL ~~FR~~ FRAGMENTS AND TIPS OF PHALANXES MAY BE FOUND IN THE SAMPLE BUCKETS.
