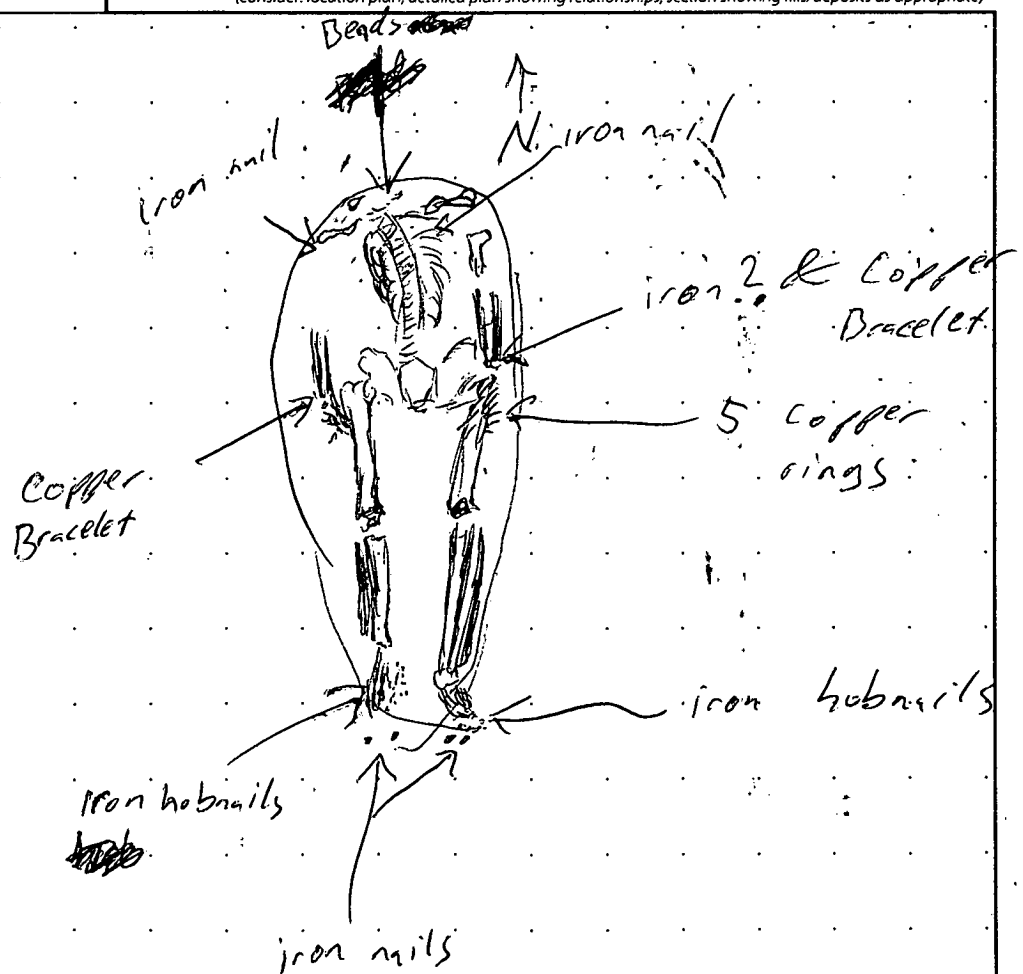

Beads & small bones likely to be found in the soil sample tubs. 2mm mesh recommended as the beads are very small. Some fairly large stones right on top of the bones. Head lost due to poor machine matching, upper thoracic and lower cervical bones broken too. In addition, left humerus put back wrong way up, and left ribs (first three) and scapula not in articulation.
