The skeleton has a fair preservation. It has been damaged before finding, and it has also received a bit of damage during the excavation. It has a NW-SE orientation and a crouched position. The cranium is quite fragmented, and together with it, part of left arm of the skeleton 381833 has been collected, since it was under the cranium, and they couldn't be separated without danger the integrity of the cranium. A part of left mandible has been recovered, and a few ~~vertebrae~~ vertebrae and ribs. Two fragments of left humerus have found, but not any of the hands and the right arm. One fragment of each femur has found, and one fragment of the left tibia, and two of the right, as well as a little fragment of the pelvis, but not anything of the feet. Some fragments of bones have found moved and they couldn't identify to that bone they belong, neither they are of the skeleton 381833 or 381834.

The skeleton was located to SE of skeleton 381833, with the left arm of 381833 under the cranium of 381834. Both were on a bed of stones, in the cut 381829, that it has a circular

shape, and were covered by the gills 381831 and 381832. They seem to be in primary situation, and next them, in the gill 381832, two fragments of pot have been found.
