Fill of sandy silt soil, of dark brownish grey colour and loose compaction. It has a maximum thickness of 0'28 m. There are moderate inclusions of chalk and stones (6/8 cm). It has occasional manganese and charcoal. It is the most modern natural infilling of the ditch [385590], and only appears in the W half of this slot. It has a linear shape, with NE-SW orientation, and in the middle of the slot (more/less) disappears, but to appear later to NE, near to the slot. Occasional ~~small~~ animal bones and Roman pottery found.
