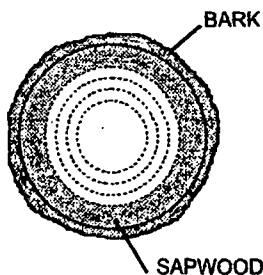

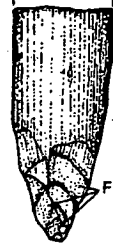
THE OVERALL CONSERVATION STATE IS GOOD AND 3 NAILS ARE STILL PRESENT ON THE TIMBER. PROBABLE OLD ALE MARKS ARE VISIBLE AROUND THE KNOT OF THE TIMBER. VERY STANDARDISED DIMENSIONS.
