FILL OF WT [7300975] TAPE OF DARK ~~SANDS~~ ORGANIC ~~SANDS~~ SILTY SOIL, WITH SOME MIDDLE SIZED STONES AND GRAVEL, CHALK AND CHARCOAL. THE LAYER MIGHT BE INTERPRETED AS A NATURAL INFILLING OF SOIL INTO THE BEAMSLOT [7300975].

SOME FRAGMENTS OF ANIMAL BONES AND POTTERY WERE FOUND.

SAME AS (7300865)

WHILE 100% THIS FEATURE IT BECAME APPARENT THAT A SEPARATION BETWEEN FINDS COMING FROM THE TOP AND THOSE FROM THE BOTTOM MIGHT BE USEFUL (AS MANY SHEETS OF POT WERE LYING FLAT AT BOTTOM OF CUT) AND ARE THUSLY MARKED ON THE BAGS. THIS NORTHERN HALF OF FEATURE WAS MUCH RICH IN FINDS THEN THE REST OF THE FEATURE. FINDS HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO (7300976) OR ~~(7301125)~~ BASED ON RELATIVE CLOSNESS TO EITHER SLOT. IN GENERAL (7300976) FINDS ARE ALL FROM THE 2° HALF OF TERMINUS; (7301125) ARE FROM SOUTH OF THAT.

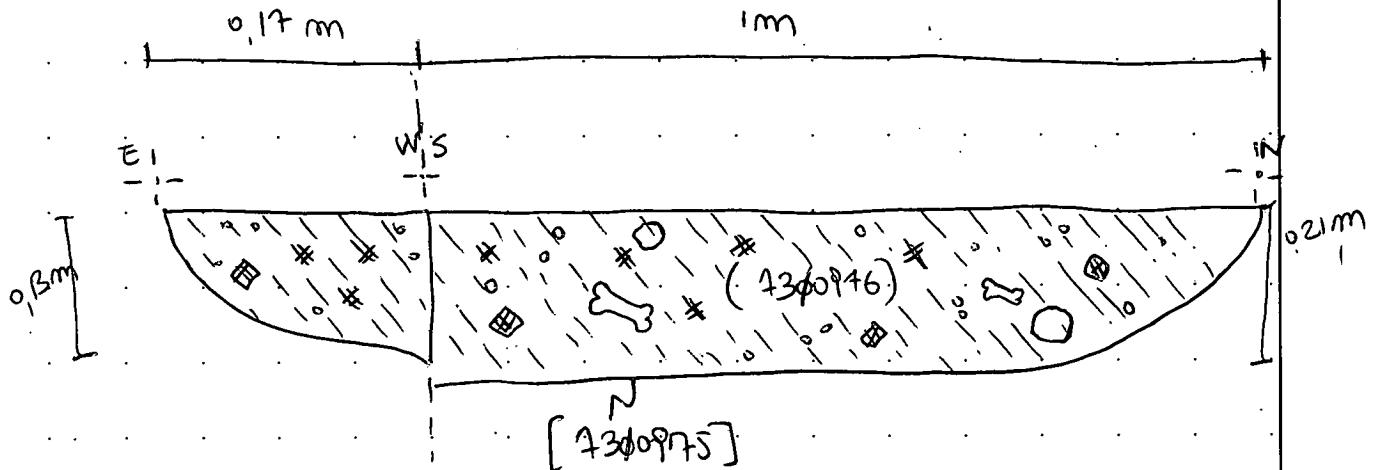
