DITCH FILL (769213) IS OF GREYISH BROWN COLOUR AND COMPOSED OF SILTY CLAY WITH MODERATE GRAVEL INCLUSIONS. - THIS FILL APPEARS SIMILAR IN APPEARANCE TO FILL (769217). HOWEVER, FILL (769213) LAYS ACROSS THE ENTIRE DITCH AS A BAND.

SMALL FINDS 76951 AND 76952 APPEAR MODERN IN ADDITION TO THE BONE EXCAVATED.

HOWEVER A PIECE OF POTTERY EXCAVATED WAS ESTIMATED TO BE MEDIEVAL.
