During excavation of this quadrant it was decided that quadrant C101932 was under excavated. Therefore the depth of this quadrant recorded and drawn in the section is incorrect. It was dug to a similar depth as C102188J.

The photographs are for the fully excavated SFB.

Measurements are given are for the entire SFB, due to accidental removal of drawing points for quadrants during cleaning and the re-excavation of C101932. The points had been previously surveyed.
