Skeleton ~~111369~~ appears to be buried in a prone position with only legs + pelvis remaining articulated. A piece of folded iron ~~111369~~ was recovered near the right tibia which a copper disc with chain/lead attached was found by the right knee. From position unknown, perhaps visibility to cremations could suggest an outcast/deviant ~~but~~ though reason for copper disc is unknown. The remainder of the body has been heavily ~~rough~~ rubbed/~~truncated~~, though no cut is evident, it is possibly pit that appeared in place disturbed the body. Only a portion of the skull remained, sandier material near skull could suggest a cut. It is assumed by excavator ~~28~~ that skull is related to legs and not from a different person. Loss of feet could be due to burrowing.
