This is the fill of the burned area / possible cremation [121695]. The fill was very dark greyish-black, moderately compact silty clay. There were occasional small (0.02m) stones & frequent charcoal inclusions throughout the fill. No human remains or any other finds were identified.

As the ~~was~~ feature was situated on top of two types of natural, the base of the feature was uneven. Most of the feature was based on top of chalky gravel that was very compact, but the western side was based on top of red/brown silty clay - which allowed the fill of the feature to sink down & mix with the natural subsoil, creating a deeper base of the feature on that side.
