SKELETON (285046), NICKNAMED 'CRANE', IS WITHIN A SHALLOW GRAVE, [285045]. THE SKELETON IS LYING ON HIS BACK. PRESERVATION WAS NOT THE BEST, HOWEVER FINGERS & KNEECAPS WERE FOUND. ~~THE~~ 'CRANE' WAS IN NEAR 100% CONDITION EXCEPT FOR HIS HEAD, WHICH WAS NOT WITHIN THE GRAVE, POSSIBLY REMOVED POST DEATH, OR CAUSE OF DEATH? -

TOP VERTEBRAG WAS EXAMINED, FOR CUT MARKS BUT PRESERVATION MADE THE BONES DELICATE AND BROKEABLE. W/CLER ON CUT MARKS.

HOP NAILS FROM SHOES WERE FOUND ALONGSIDE LEFT LEG. SHOWING HE WAS MOST LIKELY CLOTHED.
