

BUILDING IN OUTER COURT.

Possibilities:

① Earlier than main house

PHASE 1

Evid. (a) Alignment - BUT Sand <sup>of house</sup> <sub>old</sub> have been altered.

(b) Rawmarsh & Cisterc. wares etc. seemingly in destrukt. layers.

(c) A few medieval sherds - unaltered.

② Later than main house:

PHASE 2 - ? Towers added.

(a) Towers similit. size

(b) Rawmarsh & Cisterc. wares → building & occupat layers?

But could be late to some other destruction.

(c) ? Destrukt. - pit - Nids T. Ware. <sup>before</sup> c. 1600. NB 1586 building

(d) ? 1906 - documents.

X ③ Later than main house:

Building: Phases 2 & 3. ? Dating.

(b) Pipe channel w. stone <sup>like tower</sup> (b) Angled stain <sup>?</sup> under E Tower - re-used masonry on top - <sup>pre-erected tower?</sup>

(c) Superstructure (b) (c) Other drainage system in E Tower cuts off (b)

W. TOWER

(a) without 'apse'

'V' pipe channel full - almost last phase of destruction
