London Gateway Dredging Watching Brief

Summary of Work Conducted Between 30th Aug and 8th Sept 2010

WA Ref: 72435

Mobilisation occurred on Mon 30th Aug 2010. The watching brief took place between Tuesday 31st Aug and Tuesday 7th Sept. The first day was spent receiving a site induction, followed by a visit to the London Gateway offices where material that was picked up from the reclaimed land area in Phase 1 of the project was subject to archaeological review. This material had come through the dredger and been deposited with the dredged material. However, the original location of the material, i.e. the area from which it was dredged, is currently unknown.

The material at the London Gateway offices consisted of nine pieces of disarticulated cattle bone, two ceramic bottles (one broken into four pieces), two cannonballs and a wooden dead eye from a ship's rigging. This material was recorded using both object records basic measurements along with a photographic record. Date will be assessed (where possible) when the material is transferred to Wessex Archaeology (WA) Salisbury office.

The following day (Wed 1st Sept) was the first day of monitoring on the dredger (*Uilenspeigel*), which had been actively dredging since Sunday 29th Aug within Zones 32, 33 and 34. The crew of the dredger had separated some examples of animal bone from the accumulated pile of dredged waste material, along with a cannonball. The accumulated pile of material contained a considerable amount of broken wood. This was subject to archaeological assessment leading to the discovery of several worked timbers, possibly disarticulated material from a wreck site. These timbers were mainly frames and were all broken. Whilst on board the dredger went to Zone 38 for one dredging trip, which resulted in the recovery of two pieces of yellow brick along with further animal bone.

Thursday 2nd Sept. The dredger was experiencing problems this day. It was therefore not possible for WA staff to get on board as the dredger was at anchor away from the site.

Friday 3rd Sept. Dredging in Zones 32, 33, and 34 continued and saw the recovery of five fragments of various types of brick, two ships timbers, a fragment of ceramic and a lead sounding weight.

Sat 4th Sept. Dredging continued in Zones 32, 33 and 34 and saw the recovery of three pieces of broken ships timbers, one section of heavily corroded iron chain and a small cannon ball.

Sun 5th Sept. Dredging continued in Zones 32, 33 and 34 and saw the recovery of seven pieces of ships timber along with three fragments of varying types of brick (including yellow bricks).

Mon 6th Sept. Dredging continued in Zones 32, 33 and 34 and saw the recovery of four pieces of ships timber, two cannonballs (one likely to have been broken by the dredger) and two pieces of (?)cattle bone. On the previous run the dredger had been slowed by 2 knots and suction was lost in the dredge head. A position for this was recorded as 51 29.315N 0 47.702E. A possible reason for this was that they hit a patch of clay or something stronger than the surrounding seabed. When raised, the dredge head contained a lot of damaged wood. Most was to damaged to be confirmed as being part of a wreck, however four pieces of wood with ships fastenings were recognisable. Therefore, in the opinion of the monitoring archaeologist, it is thought likely that the dredger went directly through a buried section of

wooden wreck, with the timbers being fragmented by the dredge head rendering much of the recovered wood un-recognisable.

Tue 7th Sept. The archaeologist was not on the dredger – time was spent compiling records. Later that day the archaeologist was informed that dredging would not be continuing within the vicinity of Sea Reach 1 and the Watching Brief was suspended. De-mobilisation occurred on Wed 8th Sept.
