## PARISH OF ST. CLEMENT DANES. CHURCHWARDENS ACCOUNTS, XXI-XXII ELIZABETH

THE MS. here transcribed formed No. 18584 of the well-known Phillipps' collection. After that collection had been dispersed this MS. passed into the possession of the late Mr. H. A. Harben, and was by him bequeathed to the London County Council, together with his library of books, prints, deeds, etc., relating to the history and topography of London and Middlesex.

It had for some time been Mr. Harben's intention to offer a transcript of the MS. for insertion in some magazine or other publication devoted to the preservation of records relating to the history and antiquities of London, as likely to prove of interest to persons engaged in the study of such records, and it has been thought well to carry this intention into effect before handing over the MS. to the London County Council.

The MS. is of the sixteenth century, on vellum, and extends to thirty-five pages, the size of each page being 11½ inches by 8¾ inches. It is in the same handwriting throughout, and contains at the end the signatures of Gabriell Goodman, who was Dean of Westminster at the date of the Account, and of Wm. Fleetwood, formerly Recorder of the City of London, both of them Justices of the Peace for the County of Middlesex.

It consists, as is usual in documents of this nature, of lists of the persons who contributed to the rate during the two half-years included in the Account, viz., 21st--22nd Elizabeth, together with the amount of their contributions, and further sets out the payments made at the end of each half-year out of the sums collected.

It is especially interesting as being an early record of

the collection of a Poor Rate, the levying of which had been authorised by an Act of Parliament so recent as the 14th Elizabeth.

The interest attaching to a record of this nature may be twofold. It may be aroused by the distinction, whether local or national, of the persons whose names are contained in it, or it may be excited by other entries illustrating the social life of the period.

The MS. under consideration is certainly not lacking in interest in the names of the parishioners, for we find amongst the residents in the parish at this time the names of Sir Wm. Cecil, Knight, Baron of Burghley, Lord Treasurer of England; the Earl of Leicester, no other than Robert Dudley, the celebrated favourite of the Queen; the Earl of Arundel, the Earl of Bedford, commonly called the "good Earl of Bedford," who died at Bedford House, Strand, in 1585, besides others of lesser note.

There are other names included in the record that have a familiar sound, such as John Stowe, John Foxe, etc., but it is only too likely that this is mere coincidence, as there does not appear to be any reason to believe that the famous authors who bore these names ever themselves resided in or had property in the Parish of St. Clement Danes.

As to the Accounts themselves, they would hardly have satisfied the requirements of a Local Government Board auditor of the present day.

In the first place the payments in reality appear to be in excess of the receipts. In the totals of the ordinary and extraordinary payments for the first half-year, the sum of £6 6s. 8d., the total of one of the additions, appears to have been omitted altogether, reducing the expenditure to £29 5s. 8d., instead of £35 12s. 4d., the true addition. The total amount for the two half-years together should be as follows:—

and not £39 10s. as stated.

It would be interesting to compare the receipts and payment here recorded with the total amounts collected and paid for the same purposes within the limits of the parish at the present day.

The entries in the MS., apart from the lists of names, are not numerous, but one of them at least may be cited as throwing some light on the religious life of the day. It occurs under the heading "Forfaytures," and is as follows:---
