HENDON. A cobby of the extent of the same Manor made before the Brothers or Freers Robt. of Weby, Robt. of Daulkele freer Philip of Sutton and Sir John of Newport clerk XVI day of December in the year of the reign of Edward ye son of Edward (1321) XIIIth by John Hay(ward) Stephen Nicole, John at Hegge, John G(odhewe), John Carter, Godwin at Pirye, Thomas Daw, John the Bounde, Richard Sagrym, Alexander the Smith, Richard Rolfe and John B(uchen) our bond tenants sworne who say upon their oaths as followeth.

(Note, in this cobby there was a peice torn out but it is not probable that any thing was written thereon and it is consequently perfect notwithstanding that breach in the paper.)

HENDON. Out of the extent of Anno 14° Edw: 2. ffirst the Jury doth say that the Easements of their cowhouses are worth by year iiiis. Also the Jury saith that there are 2 gardens cont. viii acres whereof the ffuite and herbage are worth by year xs. And they say there is a wind-mill there worth by year xiiis. Also they say that there is a certain shop at the church gate which is lett to ferme at iis by yeare.

Also they say there is a certain house newly erected at ye P'sons Street with a Curtelage and a Croft adjoining a. . . . be lett by yeare for vis and soe it is extended.

There is neither pawnage nor pasture may be made yearly in them faggots valued at about v<sup>d</sup>.
