

OBITUARY.

MR. ROBERT GARRAWAY RICE, J.P., F.S.A.

We deeply regret the loss of Mr. Robert Garraway Rice, who was first elected a member of our Society in 1900, and had served for many years on our Council. He was an indefatigable archaeologist and had a wonderful collection of flint implements found on the Sussex Downs, near Pulborough, where he lived. He was also a collector of old Sussex ironwork. Of our Society and of the Society of Antiquaries he was a devoted member, being very regular in his attendances. He was elected F.S.A. in 1891, served on the Council and was Vice-President from 1924 to 1926.

Many museums have been enriched by his enthusiasm as a collector, and both our Society, and the Society of Antiquaries have benefited under his will. He died in January, 1933, at the age of 80.
