Executive Summary

Mott MacDonald have been commissioned on behalf of Transport for London (TfL), to undertake an Archaeological Impact Assessment (AIA) covering the proposed Cycle Hire docking station at Abingdon Green, on land opposite No. 3 Great College Street, City of Westminster.

The docking station site lies within an Archaeological Priority Area. A search of the Greater London Historic Environments Record identified a total of 208 archaeological sites, findspots and monuments within a 250m study area around the proposed docking station site.

The site is located just to the south of the World Heritage Site of Westminster Palace, Westminster Abbey and St Margaret's Church (WHS 426). The proposed site is likely to be located on modern made ground beneath the pavement. The available 20th century cartographic information suggests that the site suffered bomb damage during the Second World War; the demolition of the former structure at the site is likely to have significantly disturbed any underlying archaeological features. A Roman building (MLO23316) was found around 4m below the ground surface in a nearby location indicating that the shallow depth of the proposed groundworks in this location is unlikely to disturb early archaeological deposits.

The likely impact from the proposed foundations upon known and potential below ground archaeological deposits are considered to be minimal, however its location just outside the boundary of Westminster Palace and the World Heritage Site (WHS 426) indicates that an archaeological watching brief during groundworks is likely to be required.

Introduction

The Scheme

TfL is proposing an expansion of the current Barclays Cycle Hire scheme. This will necessitate the installation of approximately 200 new and expanded docking stations, including some in the existing zone.

Full planning permission is required for each new or expanded site and the TfL Cycle Hire Consents Team will be preparing and submitting the necessary applications during 2011.

Archaeological Impact Assessments have been prepared for docking stations within Archaeological Priority Areas (APAs) where archaeological features will potentially be encountered at shallow depth.

Each docking station comprises a terminal and a number of docking points. Groundwork will be required for the terminal foundations and the docking point foundations.

The majority of the sites will be constructed using standard foundations which require excavation of a trench to a depth of c. 450mm and a width of c. 750mm. This depth and the extent of excavation will depend on site conditions, including the location of utilities, and will therefore vary.

Site Description

The docking station site is located in the City of Westminster, on the northern side of Great College Street, NGR: TQ 30166 79309. The site currently comprises garden space with a row of small shrubs, it is unknown whether the shrubs are in planters or whether they are planted in the ground.

Methodology

Objectives

This Archaeological Impact Assessment details the results of an assessment of the nature of the archaeological and built heritage resource within the site of the Cycle Hire docking station and surrounding study area. Where possible, the AIA will assess the likely impact upon the known and potential heritage resources which will result from the proposed development scheme.

This report will include recommendations for further archaeological works where the archaeological potential of the site or value warrants, or where additional information on the site is required. Such works would likely comprise a programme of archaeological watching brief.

The information and conclusions presented in this assessment are subject to the review and approval by Diane Abrams of the English Heritage Greater London Archaeology Advisory Service (EH GLAAS).

Sources Consulted

A study area extending 250m from the boundaries of the site has been used to assess the likely nature and extent of the archaeological and built heritage resource. The Greater London Historic Environment Record (GLHER) database of archaeological sites, finds, events, monuments, listed buildings and designations is the primary source of information concerning the current state of archaeological and architectural knowledge in the study area.

This information forms the description of the heritage baseline conditions, together with an assessment of archaeological and historical information from web based and in-house sources and available cartographic evidence for the study area.

Consultation

Consultation on this scheme will be undertaken with EH GLAAS as part of a wider discussion and scoping exercise.

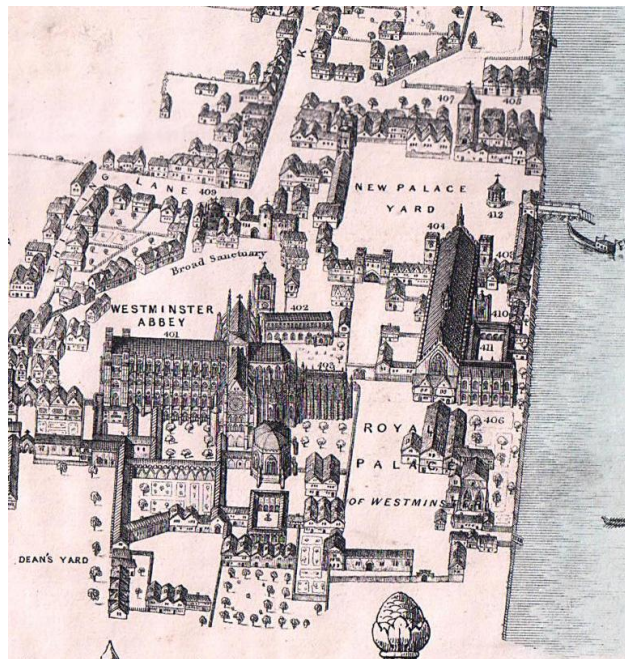
Baseline Conditions

Ground Conditions

The upper below ground conditions within the specific location of the docking station site are currently unknown, however they are expected to comprise deposits of modern made ground. The British Geological Survey map (BGS) indicates that the site is located on the boundary transition between underlying London Clay overlain by alluvium to the south and Kempton Park Gravel Formation to the north.

Cartographic Background

The earliest available map to show the site is a reconstruction of a map produced during the reign of King Henry VIII. It is not possible to establish a definite site location; however it is probable that the site lay just to the south of the Royal Palace of Westminster and to the south-east of Dean's Yard, in an unmapped section of the map.

A later map of 1593 indicates that the site is located along a road leading to 'The Queen's Slaughter howse' and 'The Myll'. The site itself is divided into four rectangular plots of land and apparently walled to the north, east and west and with open access from the road on the southern side. No buildings are located at the site.

By 1658 the site is part of an orchard to the south of ornamental gardens around the southern side of the 'Old Palace Yard'. A map dated 1720 shows 'Colledg Street' for the first time. A large structure is located on the eastern corner of the site with four small plots of land to the south, along the northern side of the road. Adjacent and to the west are three octagonal possible structures aligned north to south.

A map dated 1799 depicts a row of terraced structures aligned north to south perpendicular to College Street and fronting onto Abingdon Street, No. 18 is located in the south-eastern corner of the site. The remainder of the site comprises a large rectangular garden to the rear of No. 18. Very little change is depicted at the site until 1873 when it appears that the structures fronting onto Abingdon Street have been demolished in favour of more centrally located buildings, though it is apparent that some considerably smaller structures are present along the Abingdon Street frontage.

By 1952 the plot is empty. It is highly probable that the demolition of the previously standing structures was a consequence of World War Two bomb damage; they were depicted on the earlier 1938 Ordnance Survey map. The site has not been redeveloped and currently comprises Abingdon Gardens, a communal space.

Archaeological and Historic Background

Within the 250m study area around the proposed docking station site, the Greater London Historic Environment Record (GLHER) lists a total of 208 sites of identified archaeological Heritage Assets, (See Appendix A).

There is no recorded evidence of prehistoric activity within the site, however evidence ranging from the Palaeolithic to the late Iron Age has been recorded within 250m of the site. Much of the recorded data relate to alluvial deposits along the Thames foreshore (MLO70270, MLO70271, MLO70273, MLO70279, MLO9209 and MLO75548). Revetments dating to the prehistoric (MLO68994) and Late Mesolithic to Middle Bronze Age (MLO58930) have also been identified to the north-east. An Iron Age road or track was identified 230m to the north-east of the site (MLO2868).

The main Roman occupation of London was situated further to the east, however a small degree of activity has been identified around the site. The remains of a Roman building were found 4.26m (14 feet) below the 19th century ground surface just 65m to the west of the site (MLO23316) and another building was found around 150m to the north-west of the site (MLO12206). A hypocaust, a structure usually associated with a bath house, was discovered further to the north-west (MLO2876) and various Roman findspots have been recorded within the 250m search radius.

Edward the Confessor moved his main royal residence from the City of London upstream to the riverside location that later became known as Westminster and it is thought that an earlier church existed on Thorney Island, the area of Westminster, during the 8th century (Weinreb *et al* 2008). A number of late Saxon/early medieval archaeological and historical features have been identified within the 250m search radius around the site, nearly all of which are located within the World Heritage Site of Westminster Palace, Westminster Abbey and St Margaret's Church (WHS 426). The site is located just south of the World Heritage Site and the absence of recorded archaeological features of this date at the site combined with the later post-medieval mapping indicate that it was always located outside the boundary of Westminster Palace, Abbey and St Margaret's Church. The southern Abbey precinct wall is located immediately to the north of the site and is a Grade 1 Listed Building (DLO32778). The remains of a medieval tower were revealed during an excavation in 1963, just 15m to the west of the site, though there is no indication of the below-ground depth of the features (MLO56814). Further evidence of a wall was identified just south of the site (MLO53142).

The area was redeveloped during the early 18th century, with the construction of College Street in around 1722 (Weinreb *et al* 2008) and the cartographic information shows that the site was eventually built upon. Many of the records dating to the post-medieval period relate to listed buildings, none of which are located on, or adjacent to, the site.

Impact Assessment

Construction Impact

The available information on the station site indicates that it will comprise a terminal with a maximum 21 docking points, in two docking areas (dimensions 6.8m x 2m and 16.3m x 2m) and will have a standard foundation.

Impact on Archaeological Resource

The area of the proposed docking station site is located on land opposite No. 3 Great College Street, south of the World Heritage Site of Westminster Palace, Westminster Abbey and St Margaret's Church. Cartographic sources indicate that the site was first built upon during the 18th century and varied little between the mid 19th and 20th centuries when World War Two bomb damage resulted in the demolition of the early 20th century housing. The site was then left undeveloped and became the communal Abingdon Green.

Recommendations

Despite the high potential for significant archaeological evidence the proposed groundworks are unlikely to penetrate deeper than the expected made ground deposits used to level the site after demolition works. However, the location of the site close to a World Heritage Site and in close proximity to the walls of the abbey precinct and a medieval tower indicate that an archaeological watching brief will be required during groundworks.
