#### **Abstract**

This report documents the results of a watching brief undertaken by AOC Archaeology Group on ground breaking works associated with the erection of a house and associated infrastructure by the walled garden of Mavisbank House, Polton, Midlothian. No deposits, features or small finds of archaeological significance were found.

No further works are considered necessary.

#### 1 Introduction

#### 1.1 Background

1.1 AOC Archaeology Group was commissioned by Harley Weston to undertake a watching brief on ground breaking works associated with the construction of a house by the walled garden of Mavisbank House, Polton, Midlothian. The need for, and scope of archaeological works has been determined by Midlothian Council who are advised on archaeological matters by the East Lothian Council Archaeology Service (ELCAS).

#### 1.2 Project Background and Location

1.2.1 The development proposals (09/00156/FUL; Figure 1) involve the construction of a single dwelling house and associated infrastructure.

#### 1.3 Archaeological Background

- 1.3.1 The site lies within the designed landscape of Mavisbank House though outwith the Scheduled Ancient Monument area associated with Mavisbank House (SAM No.4921). Mavisbank House (NMRS No.NT26NE 54) lies to the north-west of the house plot.
- 1.3.2 There are no known archaeological sites within the proposed development.

#### 2 Objectives

- 2.1 Archaeological works were in the form of a Watching Brief on the excavation of building foundations at a house plot by Mavisbank, Polton, Midlothian. The aims of the archaeological Watching Brief were:
  - to safeguard the archaeological resource from any adverse impacts created by the development's groundworks;
  - ii) to liaise with ELCAS (on behalf of Midlothian Council) and the client, in the event of significant archaeological features and/or small finds being unearthed, as to the most appropriate response in safeguarding these features either by preservation *in situ*, if at all feasible, or by archaeological recording.
  - iii) to report on the results of the Watching Brief.

#### 3 Method

3.1 The site was stripped of topsoil prior to AOC's arrival on site. Following a meeting between the client, Mr. Andy Robertson of East Lothian Council and AOC, it was decided that the watching brief should comprise the monitoring of foundations in the northern fragment of the development (Figure 1).

3.2 The foundations were stripped under constant archaeological control was undertaken by machine plant equipped with a wide smooth-bladed ditching bucket. All monitoring was undertaken according to AOC Archaeology Group's standard operating procedures.

#### 4 Results

- 4.1 The watching brief was conducted over two days on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> September 2010. The weather conditions during the works were dry and sunny which rendered good archaeological visibility. The various data gathered from the watching are presented as a series of appendices:
  - i) Appendix 1 contains the photographic register;
  - ii) Appendix 2 reproduces the 'Discovery and Excavation in Scotland' entry.
- 4.2 The total area monitored comprised the excavation of foundations measuring 15 m by 30 m. The topsoil comprised up to 0.40 m of silty sandy material, overlying an orange sandy subsoil. No significant archaeological material was identified.

#### 5 Conclusion

5.1 No features, deposits or finds of any archaeological significance were recorded during the watching brief. No further archaeological works are considered necessary.





Plate 1: Working shot of area under excavation


