#### **Summary**

Wessex Archaeology were commissioned by Sheffield City Council, to update the external photographic survey of the appearance of the historic buildings and their setting contained within the limits of the Sheffield Retail Quarter Development, located within the city centre of Sheffield, South Yorkshire, centred on National Grid Reference (NGR) 435141, 387007.

The site comprises an urban cluster of streets that include industrial, financial, commercial and domestic buildings, broken by open areas of hardstanding. The area has suffered from some degradation and loss of historic fabric during the late 20th and early 21st centuries, but it still largely operates as a bustling mixed-use locality. The site comprises an irregular parcel of land that runs west to east from Trafalgar Street to Pinstone Street. The site boundary encompasses the Sheffield City Conservation Area and the Character Areas of Holly Street/Westfield Terrace/Trafalgar Street, Fargate and the Heart of the City.

This report sets out the external photographic survey made of the site, originally undertaken by ARCUS in 2008, and updated by Wessex Archaeology in 2016. The survey also included some internal photographs of the Casbah whilst open in 2008.

The photographic survey showed the site's mixed-use and evidenced continual piecemeal development throughout the 19th and 20th centuries.

The recording of the buildings set within the Sheffield Retail Quarter has produced a drawn, written and photographic archive which is currently held in Wessex Archaeology's Sheffield Office and will be delivered to the Sheffield Archives for deposition in due course. An OASIS form will be completed at http://ads.ahds.ac.uk/projects/oasis for inclusion in the ADS database. #### 1 INTRODUCTION

## 1.1 Project background

- 1.1.1 Wessex Archaeology was commissioned by Sheffield City Council (SCC) (hereafter 'the Client') to update a photographic survey of the external appearance of the historic buildings and their setting contained within the limits of the Sheffield Retail Quarter Development, located within the city centre of Sheffield, South Yorkshire, centred on National Grid Reference (NGR) 435141, 387007 (hereafter 'the Site', Figure 1).
- 1.1.2 The Site comprises an urban cluster of streets that include industrial, financial, commercial and domestic buildings, broken by open areas of hardstanding. The area has suffered from some degradation and loss of historic fabric during the late 20th and early 21st centuries but still largely operates as a bustling mixed-use locality.
- 1.1.3 The initial phase of work was carried out by Archaeological Research and Consultancy at the University of Sheffield (ARCUS) and was conducted between the 10th and 21st August 2008. Following the postponement of the development and the closure of ARCUS, the updated work has been carried out by Wessex Archaeology in 2016. The survey also includes internal photographs of the Casbah, taken by ARCUS in July 2008 to record the nightclub whilst it was still open. The report is illustrated with photographic **Plates 1-255** taken by both ARCUS in 2008 and Wessex Archaeology in 2016. Where duplications of views exist both have been included to illustrate any change in the time periods.
- 1.1.4 All works were carried out in accordance with the brief produced by SYAS (2015) which set out the requirements and methodologies for the survey. All works were carried out in accordance with industry standards and best practice (ClfA 2014, Historic England 2016).

#### 2 THE SITE

## 2.1 Site location and description

- 2.1.1 The Site comprises an irregular plot of land containing urban streets populated with mixed use buildings and areas of hardstanding. It is bound at the west by Trafalgar Street, to the north by Division Street and Barker's Pool and to the east by Pinstone Street. The southern border of the Site is stepped and starts at Wellington Street to the west and includes Charter Square and Furnival Gate respectively before joining Pinstone Street to the east (**Figure 1**).
- 2.1.2 The Site is located within the inner city ring road, immediately south-west of the centre of Sheffield City. It is approximately 0.5 km north-west of the Porter Brook, 0.7 km to the west of Sheffield Railway Station and the River Sheaf and 6 km south-west of junction 34 of the M1 motorway.

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- 2.1.3 The Site is located partially within the Sheffield City Centre Conservation Area whilst other parts of the site fall within the Holly Street/ Westfield Terrance/ Trafalgar Street, Fargate and Heart of the City Character Areas. The Site contains three listed buildings (**Appendix II**) and over 27 buildings (or groups of buildings) of 'special character' (ARCUS 2006).
- 2.1.4 The Site is approximately 6.3 hectares in size and situated on an elevation of approximately 92 m above Ordnance Datum (aOD) to the north-west that slopes to the south-east, reaching 84 m aOD at the junction of Pinstone street and Furnival Gate. The Site is underlain by bedrock geology of the Pennine Lower Coal Measures sandstone, siltstone, sandstone, coal, ironstone and ferricrete of the Carboniferous Period (British Geological Survey (BGS)).

#### 3 AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

#### 3.1 Photographic survey

- 3.1.1 The principal aim of the archaeological works was to identify and objectively record by means of photographs the extant structures contained within the Site in their current setting.
- 3.1.2 Specific aims of the work were:
  - to produce a general external photographic record of each building/building complex;
  - to produce an external photographic record of the extant structures in their current setting;
  - to produce a report which will present the results of the photographic survey in sufficient detail.
- 3.1.3 The objective of the work is to place the crossed referenced, long-term record of the building in the public domain by depositing it with Sheffield Archives and completing an online OASIS form.

#### 4 METHODOLOGY

#### 4.1 Scope of the historic building recording

- 4.1.1 The scope of the recording works has taken the form of an external photographic survey of the Site.
- 4.1.2 The photography of the Site was based on the requirements specified by SYAS (2015) and comprised general views of each building/building complex in its wider setting.
- 4.1.3 The photographic record comprises medium format black and white images with a selection of colour prints. Internal digital images were also taken inside the Casbah night club, part of the Grosvenor Hotel Block (Building 33). This nightclub had replaced the former Wapentake Bar, located at basement level within the Grosvenor Hotel Block.
- 4.1.4 The location and direction of each photographic viewpoint was recorded onto the corresponding base mapping. These have been complemented with photographic registers which, as a minimum, give the direction of the view and a brief description of the subject, and are included at the back of this report in **Appendix I**. Each viewpoint of the photographic record has been used to illustrate this report and can be found in **Plates 1-255**, whilst plate viewpoints can be found on **Figures 2-4**.

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4.1.5 The full photographic record, together with copies of the marked up plans and photographic registers will be included in the Site archive. All recording was undertaken in line with Historic England (2016) and CIfA (2014) guidelines.

#### 5 HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

#### 5.1 Introduction

5.1.1 A detailed historical narrative was previously produced by ARCUS 2005a and is summarised below.

#### 5.2 Early to medieval

5.2.1 There is little evidence for activity from the prehistoric to Roman periods within the Site. Sheffield is mentioned in Domesday as *Scafeld* which derives from the Old English *scēath* + *feld* meaning 'Open land by the River Sheaf' (Mills 1991). During the medieval period settlement activity is thought to have focused around Sheffield Castle with the Site being outside of this area (ARCUS 2005a).

#### 5.3 Post-medieval

5.3.1 Cottages to the north-east of the Site around Barker's Pool are known to exist by 1637 from documentary and cartographic sources, with the pool first documented in 1567. By 1737 the western side of Cambridge Street (formally Coal Pit Lane) is fully developed. As the name suggests industrial activity in the form of coal pits is thought to have taken place to the east of Cambridge Street but the extent is unknown. Borehole analysis undertaken by ARCUS in 2005 did not identify any evidence to suggest that mining has occurred in any of the coal measures within the site (ARCUS 2005b). The scale of subsequent development in the area is thought to have largely removed any archaeological evidence for this period (ARCUS 2005a).

#### 5.4 18th – 20th centuries

5.4.1 The Site was progressively developed from the mid-18th century onwards with the whole area being fully developed by the 1850s. The Site evolved around a grid street system that remains largely intact today. However, common piecemeal redevelopment has led to a loss of historic fabric over large swathes of the Site and the majority of historic buildings located within the Site date from the 19th century onwards (ARCUS 2005a).

#### 6 DISCUSSION

- 6.1.1 The photographic survey was carried out on the 22nd March and the 19th May 2016 by Wessex Archaeology. This updated the record previously made by ARCUS in 2008.
- 6.1.2 Images taken by ARCUS in 2008 are also presented within this report.
- 6.1.3 This report represents a photographic gazetteer of the views along the development area showing the extant buildings and their current setting. The buildings were previously coded with numbers as part of a Desk-based Assessment undertaken by ARCUS (2005a) which are also used here for consistency purpose. The buildings included are:

- 6.1.4 The Site has undergone continual change throughout the past three centuries as is typical of a city centre urban site.
- 6.1.5 The programme of recording has produced a photographic record and figures showing the photographic viewpoints to form a long term record of this part of Sheffield City Centre over the period 2008-2016. This long-term record will be placed in the public domain by depositing it with Sheffield Archives along with a copy of this report.

#### 6.2 Archive

- 6.2.1 The recording of the buildings within the Sheffield Retail Quarter has produced a written and photographic archive which is currently held in Wessex Archaeology's Sheffield Office and will be delivered to the Sheffield Archives for deposition in due course. If necessary, the paper records of the site archive will be security microfilmed prior to deposition.








Plate 31: Oblique view of the south-west corner of Building 11 (ARCUS 2008)

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


Plate 34: Oblique view of north-west corner elevation Fire Station, Building 12 with vehicular entrance (ARCUS 2008)

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

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


Plate 52: View of the south facing elevation of Building 41 (ARCUS 2008)

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

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


Plate 60: General view looking south down Backfields (ARCUS 2008)

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


Plate 65: General view looking north up Backfields (ARCUS 2008)

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


Plate 67: General view of Bethel Walk from Backfields, looking east (ARCUS 2008)

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



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






Plate 100: View of the principal east facing elevation of Building 15, Cambridge Street (ARCUS 2008)

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



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

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




Plate 163: Oblique view of the north facing elevation of the 'Grosvenor Hotel' accommodation to Building 23, looking south-east (ARCUS 2008)

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




Plate 165: General view of Charles Street showing Buildings 24, 21, 20b and 27, looking north-west from Pinstone Street (ARCUS 2008)



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


Plate 200: View of the south-east facing elevations of Buildings 29 and 30 showing various retail units, Pinstone Street (ARCUS 2008)



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


Plate 208: Detail of gate post inscribed 'Laycock House' at the rear of Building 29, Cross Burgess Street (ARCUS 2008)

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


Plate 237: Oblique view of the north facing elevation of Building 36, Barker's Pool, looking south-west (ARCUS 2008)

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


Plate 241: View west along unnamed alley between Buildings 36 and 40 (ARCUS 2008)




Plate 242: Detail of historic painted advertisement on the south facing elevation of Building 36 (ARCUS 2008)



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


Plate 243: View of the principal east facing elevation of Building 40 at the north end, Pinstone Street (ARCUS 2008)

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


Plate 249: View of the principal east facing elevation of Building 38 at the central section, Pinstone Street (ARCUS 2008)


