The clay tobacco pipe by Jennifer R. McNulty

Two stem fragments weighing 6g were recovered from fill (3501). The fragments were up to 32mm in length and no decoration was recorded on either fragment. Based on the borehole sizes, these fragments date from approximately the 18th to the 19th century (Table 1). This is due to the reduction in hole diameter over time as techniques changed and finer wire was used.
