SUMMARY OF FIELDWORK RESULTS:




Fig.1. Site Location

The watching brief took place in advance of the construction of houses, immediately north of 'The Old Vicarage' (Figure 1). It observed the removal of the topsoil, and inspected the underlying natural clay, silt and gravel for archaeological features and finds. No archaeological features or finds were detected. The topsoil was 0.05m to 0.15m deep. Modern features and disturbance occurred in the south and west parts of the development area. The modern disturbance and the shallow depth of the topsoil suggested that the site had been previously stripped and reinstated, possibly during the construction of two adjacent schools.
