Hard, thick dark brown patina. Several fragments including part of flat base. D of base 5cm, D of rim 4cm, D of neck 1.5cm, L of neck 4.5cm. Th of glass max 3mm, min 2mm.

- 57 POTTERY: fragment of Attic? black paint obverse and red on reverse as in Attic figure stuff. Two ^{ridges round exterior} concentric red trails decorating black. pinkish fine paste. L 3.5 cm. W 1.4 cm. th 3 mm.
- 58 GLASS: fragments of vessel possibly small bowl? clear with bl/gr tinge though almost entirely disintegrating; white patina - D of rim? 8 cm approx. th 3.5 mm.
59. GLASS: small deep bowl, only a few fragments missing, heavy whitish buff patina, impossible to determine colour (probably clear with bl/gr tinge) since the middle has become powdery white. Plain rim formed by trail added and marvered on the exterior, but only marvered on half the interior. Rim slightly outward curving. Four pinched decorations fairly evenly spaced around the lower part of the bowl. Sides sloping inwards. D of rim 8 cm: D of base 6 cm. th 1.5 mm - 2 mm. HF 6.5 cm.
