

Courses in Archaeology & Local Studies 1974-75

Last year nearly one hundred courses in these and related studies were offered by the Department and were held in all parts of the London Region. This year's programme will be similar and will include part-time evening lecture courses, residential and non-residential week-ends, and residential one-week courses.

A very wide range of subjects, from World Prehistory to Local Studies in the London region, is available through Extension and Tutorial classes.

Among these courses are:

1. Those which lead through annual examinations to Extension Diplomas in Archaeology, History and Local History, or to a Certificate in Field Archaeology.

2. Those which, without examination, study and practise the techniques of excavation, field-surveying and environmental archaeology under professional archaeologists.

3. Those which offer accounts of the present state of research in particular fields. Of special interest this year will be a course on selected Problems and Achievements in World Archaeology to which leading archaeologists will contribute. There are no entrance requirements, other than a willingness to study seriously under direction.
