Subject: Archaeological Watching brief at Uppacott, Harepath Hill, Seaton, Devon.		
Description: <p>Groundworks for the re-profiling of an extended rear garden were monitored and recorded. The monitored area (see attached plan) lies 150m to the south of Seaton Down Hillfort, and 500m north of the multi-period settlement of Honeyditches.</p> <p>The development area (50m long x 5m wide) lay parallel to the rear of the property (see plan). Topsoil was removed in spits down to the level of underlying subsoil, using a machine fitted with a grading bucket.</p> <p>No archaeological features or deposits were exposed, and no finds recovered.</p>	Ref: EA Project 6259	Date: 07/09/2007

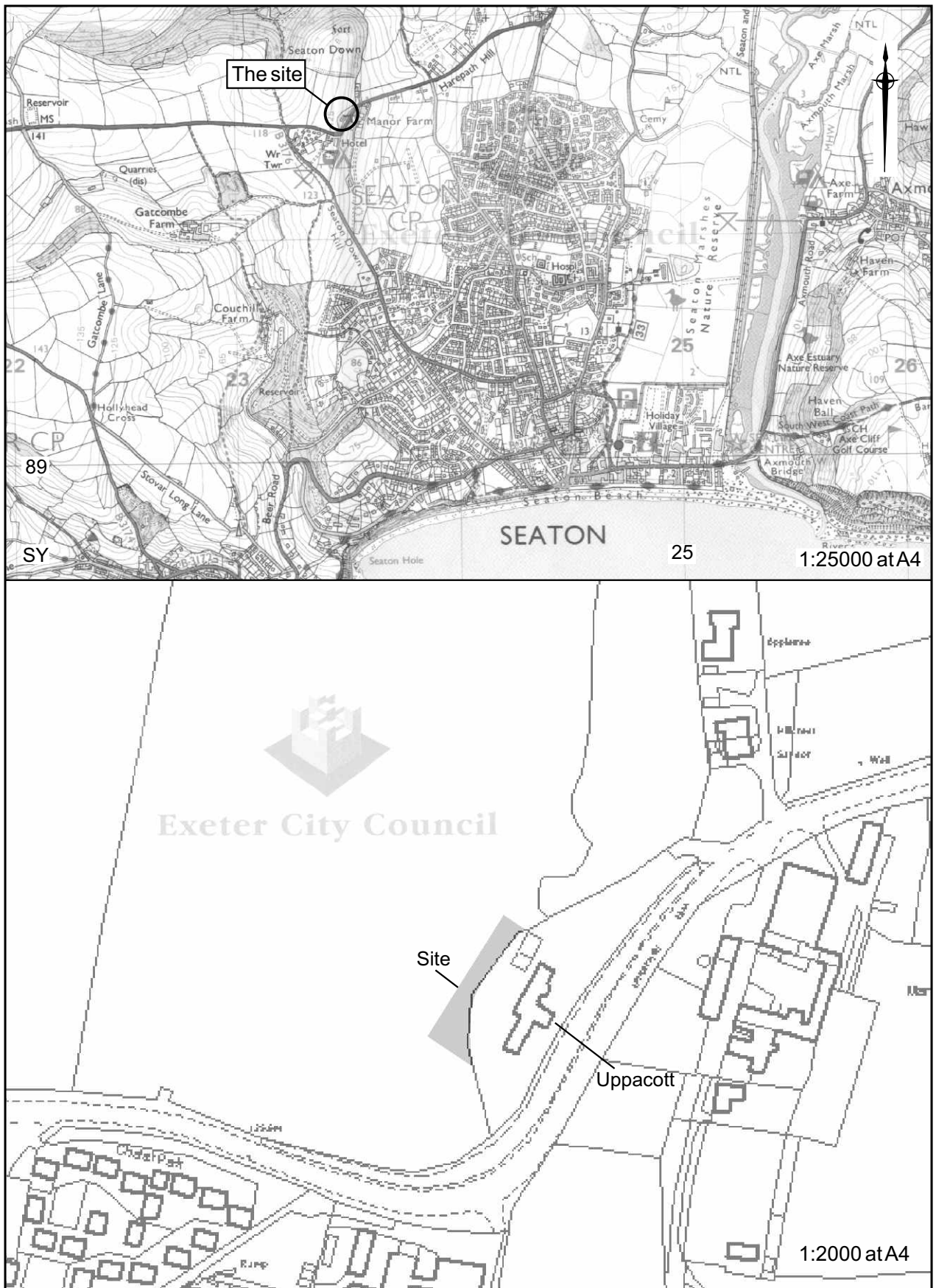


Fig. 1 Location of site. Reproduced from the Ordnance Survey mapping with the permission of The Controller of Her Majesty's Stationery Office. © Crown copyright. Exeter City Council 100025345.
